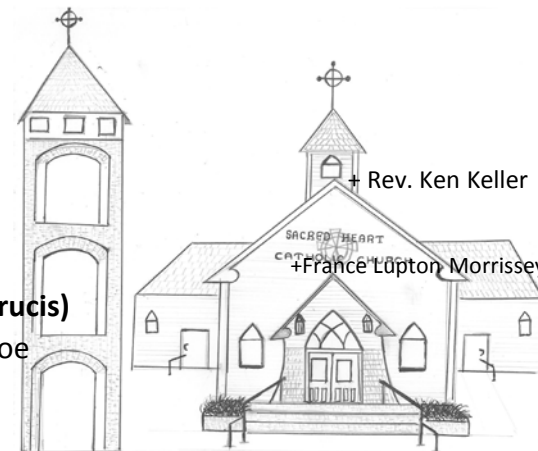

Pope Francis says he loves to pray “the Way of the Cross”



Vatican City, (CNA/EWTN News).- Everyone should pray the Stations of the Cross, Pope Francis said on Ash Wednesday, revealing that he always has with him a pocket-size book of “Via Crucis” meditations to pray with when he has a spare moment. “Walking with Mary, behind Jesus carrying the cross, is the school of Christian life: there you learn patient, silent, and concrete love,”

Letting people in on a “secret,” the pope pulled out of his pocket a small Way of the Cross booklet, which he said was a gift from when he was in Buenos Aires that he always carries with him. “And when I have time, I follow the Via Crucis. Pray the Via Crucis,” he encouraged, “because [it is] to follow Jesus with Mary on the way of the cross, where he gave his life for us...” In Panama,” he said, “young people carried, with Jesus and Mary, the burden of the condition of so many suffering brothers and sisters in Central America and in the whole world. His message to young people at the event’s culminating Mass, was that young people are called to live the Gospel today, because they are not “‘tomorrow,’ they are not the ‘in the meantime,’ but they are the today of the Church and of the world.” In his homily, Pope Francis reflected on the three areas the Lord invites Catholics to focus on during Lent – almsgiving, prayer, and fasting. “What are they for?” he asked. “Prayer reunites us to God; charity, to our neighbor; fasting, to ourselves.”

The season of Lent is an invitation to focus first on God, he continued, then on charity toward others, and “finally, Lent invites us to look inside our heart, with fasting, which frees us from attachment to things and from the worldliness that numbs the heart.” “Lent is the time to free ourselves from the illusion of chasing after dust,” he urged. “Lent is for

El papa Francisco dice que le encanta rezar "el camino de la cruz"



Ciudad del Vaticano, (CNA / EWTN News) .- Todos deben rezar las Estaciones de la Cruz, dijo el Papa Francisco el Miércoles de Ceniza, revelando que siempre lleva consigo un libro de bolsillo. Meditaciones de "Vía Crucis" para rezar cuando tenga un momento libre. "Caminar con María, detrás de Jesús cargando la cruz, está la escuela de la vida cristiana: allí aprendes un amor paciente, silencioso y concreto". Dejando que la gente contara un "secreto", el Papa sacó de su bolsillo un pequeño folleto del Camino de la Cruz, que dijo que era un regalo de cuando estaba en Buenos Aires y que siempre lleva consigo. "Y cuando tenga tiempo. , Sigo la Vía Crucis. Reza la Vía Crucis ", alentó," porque [es] seguir a Jesús con María en el camino de la cruz, donde dio su vida por nosotros ... " En Panamá ", dijo," los jóvenes llevaban, con Jesús y María, el La carga de la condición de tantos hermanos y hermanas sufrientes en América Central y en todo el mundo. Su mensaje a los jóvenes en la misa culminante del evento, el 27 de enero, fue que los jóvenes están llamados a vivir el Evangelio hoy, porque no son "mañana", no son "mientras tanto", pero son el día de hoy. de la Iglesia y del mundo ". En su homilía, el Papa Francisco reflexionó sobre las tres áreas en las que el Señor invita a los católicos a enfocarse durante la Cuaresma: la limosna, la oración y el ayuno. "¿Para qué son?", Preguntó. “La oración nos une a Dios; la caridad, a nuestro prójimo; Ayunando, a nosotros mismos ". La temporada de Cuaresma es una invitación a centrarse primero en Dios, continuó, luego en la caridad hacia los demás y, finalmente, la Cuaresma nos invita a mirar dentro de nuestro corazón, con ayuno, que nos libera del apego a las cosas y de la mundanalidad que adormece el corazón ". La Cuaresma es el momento de liberarnos de la ilusión de perseguir el polvo ", instó. “La Cuaresma es para redescubrir que estamos creados para la llama inextinguible, no para las cenizas que desaparecen de inmediato; por Dios, no por el mundo; por la eternidad del cielo, no por engaño terrenal; por la libertad de los hijos de Dios, no por la esclavitud a las cosas ".
