Holy Trinity Sunday

Today is Holy Trinity Sunday. The term “Trinity” itself is not mentioned anywhere in the Bible. However, Christ instructed us: “Go into the world and baptize them, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit” (Mt 28:19). Hence, the Church teaches us that: “The divine persons are relative to one another...the real distinction of the persons from one another resides solely in the relationships which relate them to one another...because of that unity, the Father is wholly in the Son, and wholly in the Holy Spirit...” (CCC255).

There are many lessons to learn from today’s solemnity. These includes that, we must learn to remain united in faith. Today’s celebration also reminds us that, although we are called to be united, each one of us is unique. This is expressed in the different modes of spirituality which exists in the Church. In spite of these, we are still united in the pursuit of God’s kingdom. So, none should be deprived of his uniqueness. Therefore, as one united, “but not uniform people,” we must continue to work for the progress of God’s kingdom.

Furthermore, just as each of the three divine persons, we must not be selfish or work for our personal gratifications. No member of the Trinity oppresses or takes advantage of the other. So, we must avoid manipulating, oppressing or suppressing other members of our families, communities, and church. We should learn to live in harmony with one another in spite of our individual differences and uniqueness. We must avoid treating other members unjustly as if they are not important or do not belong to the same family or community of God.

We can live harmoniously together in this big family and universal church of Christ without bursting the ego of others, or robbing them of their dignity and uniqueness. For us as humans, conflicts are inevitable. However, when we confront them prayerfully as a united family, they help to strengthen our unity. So, if we must remain united, we cannot resolve our conflicts through hatreds, gossips, and unjust criticisms of one another.

Finally, today we must learn from the three divine persons how to love and respect one another. This also means, complimenting and appreciating the efforts of one another. If we live in harmony as the Most Holy Trinity, then: “The greatness of the name of the Lord will be made known through all the earth” (Ps 8:2).

El Domingo De La Trinidad

Hoy es el Domingo de la Santísima Trinidad. La doctrina y la teología de la Trinidad es un misterio que sobrepasa todas formas de cálculos matemáticos y lógicos. El término “Trinidad” así mismo no se encuentre en la Biblia. Sin embargo, Cristo nos instruyó: “Vayan a todo mundo, bautizarlos en el nombre del padre, del hijo, y del Espíritu Santo” (Mt 28:19). Por lo tanto, la Iglesia nos enseña que: “Las personas divinas son relativas uno con el otro...la distinción real de las personas entre sí reside únicamente en que se relaciona con uno u otro. Debido a la unidad, el padre está totalmente en el Hijo, y totalmente en el Espíritu Santo” (CIC 255).

Hay muchas lecciones que aprender de la solemnidad de hoy. Debemos aprender a permanecer unidos en la fe. La celebración de hoy también nos recuerda que, aunque estamos llamados a estar unidos, cada uno de nosotros es único. Esto se expresa en los diferentes modos de espiritualidad que existe en la iglesia. A pesar de esto, todavía estamos unidos en la búsqueda del reino de Dios. Por lo tanto, ninguno debe ser privado de su singularidad. Por lo tanto, todos unidos como uno, aun siendo único, debemos seguir trabajando para llegar reino de Dios.

Además, como cada una de las tres personas divinas, no debemos ser egoístas o trabajar solamente for nuestras satisfacciones personales. Ningún miembro de la Trinidad oprime o se aprovecha de los demás. Por lo tanto, no debemos manipular, oprimir o suprimir otros miembros de nuestras familias, comunidades o Iglesia. Deberíamos aprender a vivir en armonía, uno con el otro a pesar de nuestras diferencias individuales y singularidad. Debemos evitar tratar a los demás injustamente como si ellos no son importantes o no pertenecieran a la familia o comunidad de Dios.

Podemos vivir armoniosamente juntos en esta gran familia y la Iglesia universal de Cristo, robar el otro su dignidad y singularidad. Como seres humanos, los conflictos son inevitables. Sin embargo, cuando los superamos a través de nuestra oración, nos ayudan a fortalecer y mantener nuestra unidad.

Finalmente, hoy debemos aprender de las tres divinas personas, como amarnos y respetarnos mutuamente. Esto también significa, felicitar y agradecer los esfuerzos de unos a los otros. Si logramos a vivir en armonía como la Santísima Trinidad, entonces: “La grandeza del nombre del Señor se dará a conocer en toda la tierra” (Sal. 8:2).
