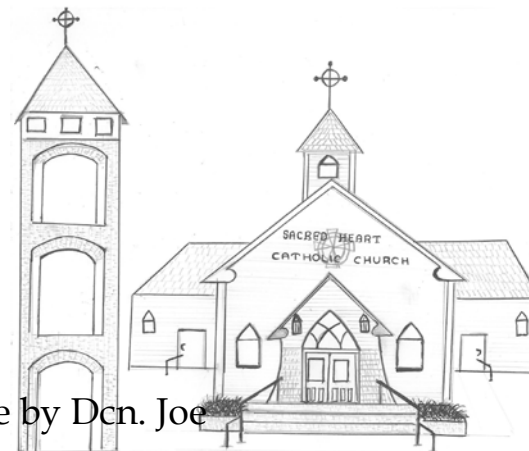

**God knows I'm sorry, isn't that enough? Why do Catholics confess their sins to a priest, rather than going directly to God?**



Well, the quick answer is because that's the way God wants us to do it. In James 5:16, God, through Sacred Scripture, commands us to "confess our sins to one another." Notice, Scripture does not say confess your sins straight to God and only to God — it says confess your sins to one another. In Matthew, chapter 9, verse 6, Jesus tells us that He was given authority on earth to forgive sins. And then Scripture proceeds to tell us, in verse 8, that this authority was given to "men"...plural.

In John 20, verses 21-23, what is the first thing Jesus says to the gathered disciples on the night of His resurrection? "Jesus said to them, 'Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, even so I send you.'" How did the Father send Jesus? Well, we just saw in Matthew 9 that the Father sent Jesus with the authority on earth to forgive sins. Now, Jesus sends out His disciples as the Father has sent Him...so, what authority must Jesus be sending His disciples out with? The authority on earth to forgive sins.

And, just in case they didn't get it, verses 22-23 say this, "And when He had said this, He breathed on them, and said to them, 'Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained.'" Why would Jesus give the Apostles the power to forgive or to retain sins if He wasn't expecting folks to confess their sins to them? And how could they forgive or retain sins if no one was confessing their sins to them?

The Bible tells us to confess our sins to one another. It also tells us that God gave men the authority on Earth to forgive sins. Jesus sends out His disciples with the authority on earth to forgive sins. When Catholics confess our sins to a priest, we are simply following the plan laid down by Jesus Christ. He forgives sins through the priest...it is God's power, but He exercises that power through the ministry of the priest.

## Dios sabe que lo siento, ¿no es suficiente?

**¿Por qué los católicos confiesan sus pecados a un sacerdote, en lugar de ir directamente a Dios?**

Bueno, la respuesta rápida es porque esa es la forma en que Dios quiere que lo hagamos. En Santiago 5:16, Dios, a través de la Sagrada Escritura, nos ordena que "confesemos nuestros pecados el uno al otro". Observe que la Escritura no dice confesar sus pecados directamente a Dios y solo a Dios; dice confesar sus pecados el uno al otro.

En Mateo, capítulo 9, versículo 6, Jesús nos dice que se le dio autoridad en la tierra para perdonar los pecados. Y luego la Escritura procede a decirnos, en el versículo 8, que esta autoridad fue dada a los "hombres" ... plural.

En Juan 20, versículos 21-23, ¿qué es lo primero que Jesús dice a los discípulos reunidos en la noche de su resurrección? "Jesús les dijo: 'La paz esté con ustedes. Como el Padre me envió, también yo os envío' ". ¿Cómo envió el Padre a Jesús? Bueno, acabamos de ver en Mateo 9 que el Padre envió a Jesús con la autoridad en la tierra para perdonar los pecados. Ahora, Jesús envía a sus discípulos como el Padre lo ha enviado ... entonces, ¿con qué autoridad debe estar enviando Jesús a sus discípulos? La autoridad en la tierra para perdonar los pecados. Y, por si acaso no lo entendieron, los versículos 22-23 dicen esto: "Y cuando Él dijo esto, sopló sobre ellos y les dijo: 'Reciban el Espíritu Santo. Si perdonáis los pecados de alguno, serán perdonados; si retienes los pecados de alguno, serán retenidos' ".

¿Por qué Jesús les daría a los apóstoles el poder de perdonar o retener los pecados si no esperaba que la gente les confesara sus pecados? ¿Y cómo podrían perdonar o retener los pecados si nadie les confesara sus pecados?

La Biblia nos dice que confesemos nuestros pecados unos a otros. También nos dice que Dios le dio a los hombres la autoridad en la Tierra para perdonar los pecados. Jesús envía a sus discípulos con la autoridad en la tierra para perdonar los pecados. Cuando los católicos confiesan nuestros pecados a un sacerdote,
