Saint John Vianney's Story (feast - Aug 4)

A man with vision overcomes obstacles and performs deeds that seem impossible. John Vianney was a man with vision: He wanted to become a priest. But he had to overcome his meager formal schooling, which inadequately prepared him for seminary studies. His failure to comprehend Latin lectures forced him to discontinue. But his vision of being a priest urged him to seek private tutoring. After a lengthy battle with the books, John was ordained. Situations calling for "impossible" deeds followed him everywhere. As pastor of the parish at Ars, John encountered people who were indifferent and quite comfortable with their style of living. His vision led him through severe fasts and short nights of sleep. With Catherine Lassagne and Benedicta Lardet, he established La Providence, a home for girls. Only a man of vision could have such trust that God would provide for the spiritual and material needs of all those who came to make La Providence their home. His work as a confessor is John Vianney's most remarkable accomplishment. In the winter months he was to spend 11 to 12 hours daily reconciling people with God. In the summer months this time was increased to 16 hours. Unless a man was dedicated to his vision of a priestly vocation, he could not have endured this giving of self-day after day. Many people look forward to retirement and taking it easy, doing the things they always wanted to do but never had the time. But John Vianney had no thoughts of retirement. As his fame spread, more hours were consumed in serving God's people. Even the few hours he would allow himself for sleep were disturbed frequently by the devil. His fame spread until people began to travel to him in 1827. Within thirty years, it is said he received up to 20,000 pilgrims each year. He was deeply devoted to St. Philomena and erected a chapel and shrine in her honor. When he later became deathly ill but miraculously recovered, he attributed his health to St. Philomena's intercession. By 1853, Fr. Vianney had attempted to run away from Ars four times, each attempt with the intention of becoming a monk but decided after the final time that it was not to be. Six years later, he passed away and left behind a legacy of faith and was viewed as the champion of the poor. On October 3, 1873, Pope Pius IX proclaimed Fr. Vianney as "venerable" and on January 8, 1905, Pope Pius X beatified him. St. John Vianney was canonized on May 31, 1925. His feast day was declared August 4.

La historia de San Juan Vianney (fiesta - 4 de agosto)

Un hombre con visión supera los obstáculos y realiza acciones que parecen imposibles. John Vianney era un hombre con visión: quería ser sacerdote. Pero tuvo que superar su escasa escolarización formal, que lo preparó inadecuadamente para los estudios de seminario. Su incapacidad para comprender las conferencias en latín lo obligó a suspender. Pero su visión de ser sacerdote lo instó a buscar clases particulares. Después de una larga batalla con los libros, John fue ordenado. Situaciones que pedían hechos "imposibles" lo seguían a todas partes. Como pastor de la parroquia en Ars, John se encontró con personas indiferentes y bastante cómodas con su estilo de vida. Su visión lo condujo a través de ayunos severos y noches cortas de sueño.

Con Catherine Lassagne y Benedicta Lardet, estableció La Providence, un hogar para niñas. Solo un hombre de visión podría tener tanta confianza que Dios proveería las necesidades espirituales y materiales de todos aquellos que vinieron a hacer de La Providence su hogar. Su trabajo como confesor es el logro más notable de John Vianney. En los meses de invierno, debía pasar de 11 a 12 horas diarias reconciliando a las personas con Dios. En los meses de verano este tiempo se incrementó a 16 horas. A menos que un hombre se dedicara a su visión de una vocación sacerdotal, no podría haber soportado esta entrega de sí mismo día tras día. Muchas personas esperan jubilarse y tomarse las cosas con calma, haciendo las cosas que siempre quisieron hacer pero que nunca tuvieron el tiempo. Pero John Vianney no tenía pensamientos de jubilación. A medida que su fama se extendió, se consumieron más horas para servir al pueblo de Dios. Incluso las pocas horas que se permitía dormir se veían perturbadas frecuentemente por el demonio. Su fama se extendió hasta que la gente comenzó a viajar a él en 1827. En treinta años, se dice que recibió hasta 20,000 peregrinos cada año. Estaba profundamente dedicado a Santa Filomena y erigió una capilla y un santuario en su honor. Cuando más tarde se enfermó de muerte pero se recuperó milagrosamente, atribuyó su salud a la intercesión de Santa Filomena. Para 1853, el p. Vianney había intentado huir de Ars cuatro veces, cada intento con la intención de convertirse en monje, pero después de la última vez decidió que no sería así. Seis años después, falleció y dejó un legado de fe y fue visto veces antes como el campeón de los pobres. El 3 de octubre de 1873, el papa Pío IX proclamó al p. Vianney como "venerable" y el 8 de enero de 1905, el papa Pío X lo beatificó. San Juan Vianney fue canonizado el 31 de mayo de 1925. Su fiesta se declaró el 4 de Agosto.
