The Rosary and Sacred Scripture: Holy Mary, Mother of God. Luke 1:43 "And how does this happen to me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me? Kyrios is the Greek word used by the Jews in the Septuagint Bible (Greek translation) for Yhwh, the Divine Name of God. In her greeting of Mary, Elizabeth is saying: "How is it that the mother of my God should come to me." Against the heresies of the 4th and 5th centuries which tried to split the Person of Jesus into two, divine and human, denying one or the other, the Council of Ephesus in 431 AD proclaimed Mary Theotokos (God-bearer, i.e. mother of God). Jesus is a single Person, a Divine Person, the 2nd Person of the Most Holy Trinity. To be mother of the Person Jesus is to be mother of a Person who is God. Mary's title protects this truth against errors which emphasize or deny, either the divinity or humanity of the Lord. **Pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death Amen:** Luke 2:35 "...and you yourself a sword will pierce so that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed." John 2:5 "His mother said to the servers, "Do whatever he tells you." Mary sees a need and appeals to Her Son to satisfy it. He does. We turn to Mary to ask her to intercede with her Son in our daily spiritual and material needs, but especially at the hour of our death. At that moment our salvation hangs in the balance as the devil makes his final foray to deter us from the path to God (Rev. 2:10). It is not surprising, therefore, that both the Hail Mary and the Our Father conclude with an appeal to be delivered from the evil one. **Fruits of the Rosary are evident within each mystery of the Rosary:** Meditations on the Rosary actually make you grow in virtue and holiness. 01. Annunciation - Humility: Being able to have a glimpse into Mary's deep humility should inspire you to strive to conform your will to that of God's will. Imitate her willingness to do God's will and your life will be permeated with serenity. This gift will be yours if you conform your will to that of God's. Even Jesus himself conformed his will to God's will to the very last measure... "Again the second time, he went and prayed, saying: My Father, if this chalice may not pass away, but I must drink it, thy will be done." -Matthew 26:42. 02. Visitation -Love of Neighbor: Mary knew Elizabeth needed her assistance. From this story, The Visitation of Mary, you can learn two things. First, that Mary will promptly assist you in your times of need

El Rosario y la Sagrada Escritura: Santa María, Madre de Dios. Lucas 1:43 "¿Y cómo me sucede esto, que la madre de mi Señor venga a mí? Kyrios es la palabra griega utilizada por los judíos en la Biblia Septuaginta (traducción griega) para Yhwh, el Nombre Divino de Dios. En su saludo a María, Elizabeth dice: "¿Cómo es que la madre de mi Dios debe venir a mí?". Contra las herejías de los siglos IV y V que trataron de dividir a la Persona de Jesús en dos, divina y humana, Negando a uno u otro, el Concilio de Éfeso en 431 dC proclamó a María Theotokos (portadora de Dios, es decir, madre de Dios). Jesús es una sola persona, una persona divina, la segunda persona de la Santísima Trinidad. Ser madre de la persona Jesús debe ser madre de una persona que es Dios. El título de María protege esta verdad contra los errores que enfatizan o niegan, ya sea la divinidad o la humanidad del Señor. **Ruega por nosotros pecadores, ahora y en la hora de nuestra muerte. Amén:** Lucas 2:35 "... y tú mismo una espada traspasará para que los pensamientos de muchos corazones puedan ser revelados". Juan 2: 5 "Su madre dijo a los servidores:" Haz lo que él te diga ". María ve una necesidad y le pide a su Hijo que la satisfaga. Él lo hace. Nos dirigimos a María para pedirle que interceda con su Hijo en nuestras necesidades espirituales y materiales diarias, pero especialmente en la hora de nuestra muerte.
