Scripture Insights: The readings for the last three Sundays of the liturgical year focus on the mystery of the resurrection of the dead. Today's First Reading, the grisly story of the martyrdom of the seven brothers in Maccabees, opens a conversation on belief in the resurrection. The covenant between God and the Chosen People included God's promise of care and salvation and a life of faithfulness by the Israelites. The issue in the text is whether this relationship extended after death. The responses of the seven brothers indicate that they firmly believe God will raise them up. Their hope and trust in God will give them the strength to endure their death. The scenario outlined in the Gospel presents the unlikely situation of seven brothers marrying the same woman and all dying without offspring. The question of the Sadducees is based on the premise that life on earth carries on in a similar way after death. Jesus' response indicates that the social conventions and relationships of this life are changed after death. He does not explain what life after death will be like, other than that it will be different; the limitations of this life will be transformed. The resurrection of the dead is a matter of faith in the God of the living. The Second Reading reminds us that it would be short-sighted to think of the resurrection as only involving the moment of death. The life of the faithful disciple is always in preparation for a new life with God in eternity. Paul encourages the early community of believers to live in the belief that the Lord Jesus gives them the strength to live in hope and to do good works. The grace of God the Father has come to them through Jesus Christ and they will endure in the love of God just as Jesus did. In the Gospel, how is Jesus' approach to the issue different from that of his questioners? What elements of hope do you find in the passage from Paul? What specific parts of the psalm might be helpful to someone facing death?

CREEMOS QUE LOS MUERTOS RESUCITARAN...

Cristo lo afirma, sin lugar, a dudas, en el evangelio de hoy. Y cada vez que decimos el Credo afirmamos nuestra adhesión a esta verdad. Esto es de vital importancia: Para los que lloramos a un ser querido cuya perdida acabamos de sufrir, porque sabemos que se ese alguien murió en amistad con Dios, Cristo ha salido a su encuentro y le ha dado la vida eterna y la felicidad sin fin. Para los que creemos en la otra vida, pero vivimos como si no creyéramos en ella, poniendo nuestros cinco sentidos en pasaría bien, o lo mejor que se pueda, en esta vida. Para los que vivimos esforzándonos por sele fieles a Dios, siendo justos y honrados, pero que a ratos nos desanimamos y nos dan ganas de arrojar el arpa de la honradez y de la justicia; porque pensar en la resurrección nos da fuerzas para seguir luchando. "Porque Dios no es Dios de muertos, sino de vivos, pues para el todos viven"

La resurrección de los muertos es una cuestión de fe en el Dios de los vivos. La segunda lectura nos recuerda que sería miope pensar que la resurrección solo implica el momento de la muerte. La vida del discípulo fiel siempre está en preparación para una nueva vida con Dios en la eternidad. Pablo anima a la comunidad primitiva de creyentes a vivir en la creencia de que el Señor Jesús les da la fuerza para vivir en la esperanza y hacer buenas obras. La gracia de Dios el Padre ha venido a ellos por medio de Jesucristo y ellos perdurarán en el amor de Dios tal como lo hizo Jesús. En el Evangelio,
