Month of the Seven Sorrows of Mary



September is traditionally dedicated to the Seven Sorrows (or Dolours) of Mary, and the Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows falls in September. The Sorrows are: the prophecy of Simeon, the flight into Egypt, the loss of the Holy Child at Jerusalem for three days, meeting Jesus on his way to Calvary, standing at the foot of the Cross, Jesus being taken from the Cross, and the burial of Christ. The graces promised by Jesus, to those who are devoted to the dolours of Mary, are very Great. Pelbert relates that it was revealed to Saint Elizabeth, that after the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin into Heaven, Saint John the Evangelist, desired to see her again. The favor was granted him; his dear Mother appeared to him, and with her, Jesus Christ also appeared; the Saint then heard Mary ask her Son to grant some special grace to all those who are devoted to her dolours. Jesus promised her four principal ones: First, that those, who before death, invoke the Divine Mother, in the name of her sorrows, should obtain true repentance of all their sins. Second, that He would protect all, who have this devotion in their tribulations, and that He would protect them, especially at the hour of death. Third, that He would impress upon their minds, the remembrance of His Passion, and that they should have their reward for it in Heaven. Fourth, that He would commit such devout clients, to the hands of Mary, with the power to dispose of them, in whatever manner she might please, and to obtain for them all the graces she might desire."

St. John Paul II said "Turn your eyes incessantly to the Blessed Virgin; she, who is the Mother of Sorrows and also the Mother of Consolation, can understand you completely and help you. Looking to her, praying to her, you will obtain that your tedium will become serenity, your anguish change into hope, and your grief into love. I accompany you with my blessing, which I willingly extend to all those who assist you."

Mes de los Siete Dolores de María



Septiembre está tradicionalmente dedicado a los Siete Dolores (o Dolores) de María, y la Fiesta de Nuestra Señora de los Dolores cae en septiembre. Los dolores son: la profecía de Simeón, la huida a Egipto, la pérdida del Santo Niño en Jerusalén durante tres días, el encuentro con Jesús en su camino al Calvario, parado al pie de la Cruz, Jesús siendo bajado de la Cruz, y el entierro de Cristo. Las gracias prometidas por Jesús a los devotos de los dolores de María son muy grandes. Pelbert relata que le fue revelado a Santa Isabel, que después de la Asunción de la Santísima Virgen al Cielo, San Juan Evangelista, deseaba volver a verla. Se le concedió el favor; se le apareció su querida Madre, y con ella apareció también Jesucristo; Entonces la Santa escuchó a María pedirle a su Hijo que concediera una gracia especial a todos aquellos que se dedican a sus dolores. Jesús le prometió cuatro principales: Primero, que aquellos que antes de la muerte invoquen a la Divina Madre, en nombre de sus dolores, obtengan el verdadero arrepentimiento de todos sus pecados. En segundo lugar, que protegería a todos los que tienen esta devoción en sus tribulaciones, y que los protegerá, especialmente en la hora de la muerte. Tercero, que imprimiera en sus mentes el recuerdo de Su Pasión, y que tuvieran su recompensa por ello en el Cielo. Cuarto, que encomendaría a clientes tan devotos, en manos de María, con el poder de disponer de ellos, de la manera que ella quisiera, y obtener para ellos todas las gracias que ella pudiera desear "

San Juan Pablo II dijo "Vuélvase incesantemente los ojos a la Santísima Virgen; ella, que es la Madre de los Dolores y también la Madre del Consuelo, puede entenderte completamente y ayudarte. Mirándola, rezándole, conseguirás que tu tedio se convierta en serenidad, tu angustia en esperanza y tu dolor en amor. Te acompaño con mi bendición, que de buen grado extiendo a todos los que te asisten "
