Celebrating Our Mother's Great Birthday

A beautiful day, September 8, the birthday of our Mother, a great day to celebrate! The Sacred Scriptures do not refer to the birth of Mary. But the "Proto Evangelium of St. James" describes Mary's parents as wealthy Joachim and Anne. They were deeply grieved by their childlessness till Mary was born to them miraculously in their old age!

This feast has originated in the sixth century, after the Council of Ephesus. The church of Angers in France claims that St. Maurilius instituted this feast at Angers in 430. On the night of 8 September, a man heard the angels singing in heaven, and on asking the reason, they told him they were rejoicing because the Virgin was born on that night.

The primary theme of this feast is that the world had been in the darkness of sin and with the arrival of Mary begins a glimmer of light. That light which appears at Mary's holy birth preannounces the arrival of Christ, the Light of the World. Thus her birth is the beginning of a new world. In **Islam**, Mary is known as "**Maryam**, mother of **Isa**" and Jesus as 'Īsā ibn Maryām'. Her status is as the only woman not touched by Satan.

The Pre-Renaissance Mary is represented as a queen: ennobled, enthroned, surrounded by angels and engulfed in celestial light. Yet she was deep in her sublime humility, devotion, faithfulness and purity. We can celebrate her birthday by imitating her and encouraging our people to do the same. Let us celebrate her birthday solemnly with her own devotion. We can also encourage our people to celebrate it in their families by praying the rosary, the litany and learning and singing a new Marian song.

Remember, O most gracious Virgin Mary,
that never was it known that anyone who fled to your protection,
implored your help, or sought your intercession, was left
unaided. Inspired by this confidence,
I fly unto you, O Virgin of virgins, my Mother.
To you do I come, before you I stand, sinful and sorrowful.
O Mother of the Word Incarnate, despise not my petitions,
but in your mercy, hear and answer me. Amen

Celebrando el gran cumpleaños de nuestra madre

Un hermoso día, el 8 de septiembre, el cumpleaños de nuestra Madre, ¡un gran día para celebrar! Las Sagradas Escrituras no se refieren al nacimiento de María. Pero el "Proto Evangelium of St. James" describe a los padres de María como los ricos Joachim y Anne. Estaban profundamente afligidos por su falta de hijos hasta que María les nació milagrosamente en su vejez.

Esta fiesta se originó en el siglo VI, después del Concilio de Éfeso. La iglesia de Angers en Francia afirma que San Mauricio instituyó esta fiesta en Angers en 430. En la noche del 8 de septiembre, un hombre escuchó a los ángeles cantando en el cielo y, al preguntarle la razón, le dijeron que se regocijaban porque la Virgen nació esa noche.

El tema principal de esta fiesta es que el mundo había estado en la oscuridad del pecado y con la llegada de María comienza un rayo de luz. Esa luz que aparece en el santo nacimiento de María anuncia la llegada de Cristo, la Luz del Mundo. Por tanto, su nacimiento es el comienzo de un mundo nuevo. En el Islam, María es conocida como "Maryam, madre de Isa" y Jesús como 'Īsā ibn Maryām'. Su estatus es como la única mujer no tocada por Satanás.

La María prerrenacentista está representada como una reina: ennoblecida, entronizada, rodeada de ángeles y envuelta en luz celestial. Sin embargo, estaba profunda en su sublime humildad, devoción, fidelidad y pureza. Podemos celebrar su cumpleaños imitándola y animando a nuestra gente a hacer lo mismo. Celebremos su cumpleaños solemnemente con su propia devoción. También podemos animar a nuestra gente a celebrarlo en sus familias rezando el rosario, la letanía y aprendiendo y cantando una nueva canción mariana.

Recuerda, oh misericordiosa Virgen María,
que nunca se supo que alguien que huyó a tu protección,
imploró tu ayuda o buscó tu intercesión, quedó sin ayuda.
Inspirado por esta confianza, Vuelo hacia ti, Virgen de las vírgenes,
Madre mía. A ti vengo, ante ti estoy, pecador y afligido.
Oh Madre del Verbo Encarnado, no desprecies mis peticiones,
pero en tu misericordia, escúchame y respóndeme. Amén
