The Parable of the 10 Virgins

The 10 virgins represent us, the Church. The lamps represent our lives and the importance of keeping the light of Christ burning brightly in our hearts. The bridegroom is Jesus, and we, as the Church, are called to be his bride. The five foolish virgins represent Christians who are not prepared to meet Jesus, and the five wise virgins represent the Christians who are prepared every day to meet Jesus. The oil for their lamps represent all that we do as Christians to keep the light of Christ burning in our lives like: going to church, receiving the Eucharist, celebrating the sacraments, going to confession, supporting the parish, praying, serving others, loving, forgiving, etc. The arrival of Jesus, the bride groom, represents when we see Jesus, at the moment of our death or when Jesus returns at the end of the world in all of his glory.

We do not know that day or that hour, so let us be like the five wise virgins, always prepared to meet Jesus, by living good, holy, Christian lives, always striving to live like saints here on earth, so that when that moment comes, and it will, we will be found ready. And instead of Jesus saying, "I do not know you" when we knock on heaven's door, Jesus will say to us, "welcome, my good and faithful servant."
