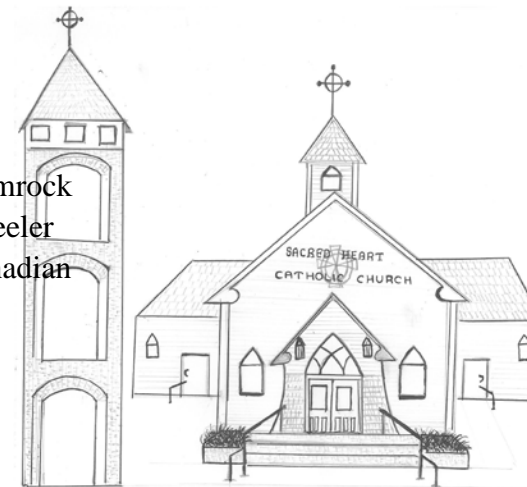

God's Time

Time is a fascinating reality that can't be seen or grasped. We can't make it stop or start, speed up or slow down. We do, however, measure it. We count days, weeks, months, or years, and regulate much of life based on the clock. In many senses, time orients us and reminds us that our days are numbered. This sort of time is "chronos" time, from Greek.

But time has another dimension to it as well, called "kairos". It refers not to duration, but to the quality, the opportunity, of a moment. That moment, whenever we speak of it or perceive it, exists in the present. We are free to respond to it, or let it pass us by.

Kairos can also be called God's time. Kairos is God's dimension—one not marked by the past, the present, or the future. The Greek word Kairos means "right, critical, opportune time, moment." These moments give life new meaning and it makes life worth living.

We should always live our days looking for those moments, those inexplicable times when His will and his way intersect with our daily walks. And they can happen anytime! God is always surprising us with his perfect, kairos timing.

La palabra griega Kairos significa "momento correcto, crítico, oportuno". Estos momentos le dan a la vida un nuevo significado y hacen que la vida valga la pena vivirla.

Siempre debemos vivir nuestros días buscando esos momentos, esos momentos inexplicables en los que su voluntad y su camino se cruzan con nuestro caminar diario. ¡Y pueden suceder en cualquier momento! Dios siempre nos sorprende con su perfecta sincronización.
