## WHAT ARE YOU LOOKING FOR?

In our gospel today we see John standing with two of his disciples, and as Jesus walk by, John said: "Behold, the Lamb of God." The two disciples heard what he said and followed Jesus. Jesus turned and saw them following him and said to them, "What are you looking for?" We too, are followers of Jesus, the Lamb of God, the One who became the sacrificial Lamb for our salvation. Today Jesus, asks us the same question, which is an indispensable question for every Christian Catholic: "What are you looking for?" Many people go through life not really knowing what they want, what to do with their lives, and unfortunately begin to drift, and get lost in a very sinful and superficial world. The correct answer to Jesus' question, "What are you looking for?", is meaning, purpose, direction, friendship with God, holiness, eternal life. God is calling, inviting, each of us to this kind of life. Let's respond to Jesus by echoing The courage and faithfulness of Samuel in the first reading and respond with him; "Here I am Lord, Your servant is listening, I come to do your will.
