REPENTANCE

In our first reading today we see Jonah preached a message of repentance to the people of Nineveh and they repented. In our gospel today we hear Jesus say: "The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel." We too, as members of God's Kingdom, are called to repentance. What does it truly mean to repent? Repentance goes beyond the feeling of regret or sorry for having committed a sin. To repent means to turn away from sin to righteousness, to experience a change of mental and spiritual attitude toward sin. So for us as Catholic Christians, we are called to be sorry for our sins and at the same time recognize the ugliness and danger of sin and make a firm resolution in our mind and heart to turn away from sin and do good.

ARREPENTIMIENTO

En nuestra primera lectura de hoy vemos que Jonás predicó un mensaje de arrepentimiento a la gente de Nínive y se arrepintieron. En nuestro evangelio de hoy escuchamos a Jesús decir: "El reino de Dios se ha acercado. Arrepiéntanse y crean en el evangelio". Nosotros también, como miembros del Reino de Dios, estamos llamados al arrepentimiento. ¿Qué significa realmente arrepentirse? El arrepentimiento va más allá del sentimiento de arrepentimiento o pena por haber cometido un pecado. Arrepentirse significa alejarse del pecado hacia la justicia, experimentar un cambio de actitud mental y espiritual hacia el pecado. Entonces, para nosotros como Cristianos Católicos, estamos llamados a lamentar nuestros pecados y al mismo tiempo reconocer la fealdad y el peligro del pecado y tomar una firme resolución en nuestra mente y corazón para alejarnos del pecado y hacer el bien.
