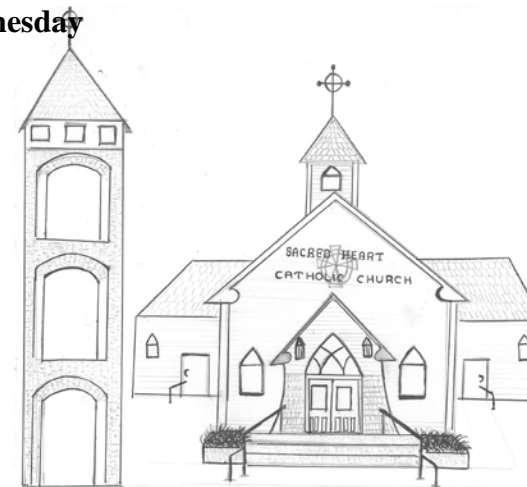

“Rend Our Hearts”

In the book of Joel we hear the Lord say: “Rend your hearts not your garments.” It was the custom of ancient Jewish people to vigorously tear one's clothing as a visible sign of deep emotion. Whether it be anger, grief, contrition or any other intense, overwhelming emotion, the rending of your clothes was an outward sign of your inward feelings.

But many customs can become purely habits that are done without any serious thought. When they are not genuine expressions of our inner feelings they can become just a show we put on for others to see.

So let us “rend our hearts” so they can be emptied of all that we no longer need, so that we can be emptied of all the junk, all the sin that we allowed the world to put there, and allow our Lord to fill us up with his grace, love, mercy and forgiveness.

So let us, this Lenten season, return to the Lord Jesus with our whole heart, with fasting, penance, almsgiving, and prayer, so that this season can truly be for us a season of repentance, a season of conversion, in which Jesus restores our hearts as only he can.

"Desgarrar Nuestros Corazones"

En el libro de Joel oímos al Señor decir: "Rasgad nuestro corazón, no nuestros vestidos". Era costumbre de los antiguos judíos rasgarse vigorosamente la ropa como señal visible de profunda emoción. Ya sea ira, dolor, contrición o cualquier otra emoción intensa y abrumadora, rasgarse la ropa era un signo externo de sus sentimientos internos.

Pero muchas costumbres pueden volverse puramente hábitos que se hacen sin pensarlo seriamente. Cuando no son expresiones genuinas de nuestros sentimientos internos, pueden convertirse en un espectáculo que ponemos para que otros lo vean.

Volvamos, pues, en este tiempo de Cuaresma al Señor Jesús con todo nuestro corazón, con abstinencia, penitencia, caridad y oración, para que este tiempo sea verdaderamente para nosotros un tiempo de arrepentimiento, un tiempo de conversión, en el que Jesús restaura nuestros corazones como solo él puede.
