EMMAUS

In today's gospel we hear: "The two disciples recounted what had taken place on the way, and how Jesus was made known to them in the breaking of bread."

In this Emmaus experience we have the pattern of the Mass. First Jesus explained sacred scripture to them, then he made himself known, and present to them in the breaking of the bread. The Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist, both are essential in the true encounter of Christ. And we are clearly reminded, through this story, as sacred as God's Word is, it is not enough, we must be fed not just with his Word, but with Jesus himself in the Eucharist. Because it was in the breaking of the bread they recognized Jesus.

Let us reverence and cherish God's holy Word, and most importantly, let us reverence and cherish Jesus Christ, body, blood, soul, and divinity, in the Eucharist, so that our eyes too will be opened to a truly authentic encounter with the living Jesus Christ this Easter Season.

EMMAUS

En el evangelio de hoy escuchamos: "Los dos discípulos contaron lo que había sucedido en el camino, y cómo Jesús les fue dado a conocer en la fracción del pan".

En esta experiencia de Emaús tenemos el patrón de la Misa. Primero Jesús les explicó la Sagrada Escritura, luego se dio a conocer y se les presentó en la fracción del pan. La Liturgia de la Palabra y la Liturgia de la Eucaristía, ambas son esenciales en el verdadero encuentro de Cristo. Y se nos recuerda claramente, a través de esta historia, que tan sagrada como es la Palabra de Dios, no es suficiente, debemos ser alimentados no solo con su Palabra, sino con el mismo Jesús en la Eucaristía. Porque fue en la fracción del pan que reconocieron a Jesús.

Reverenciamos y apreciemos la santa Palabra de Dios, y lo más importante, reverenciamos y apreciemos a Jesucristo, en cuerpo, sangre, alma y divinidad, en la Eucaristía, para que también nuestros ojos se abran a un encuentro verdaderamente auténtico con el vivo Jesucristo en esta temporada de Pascua.
