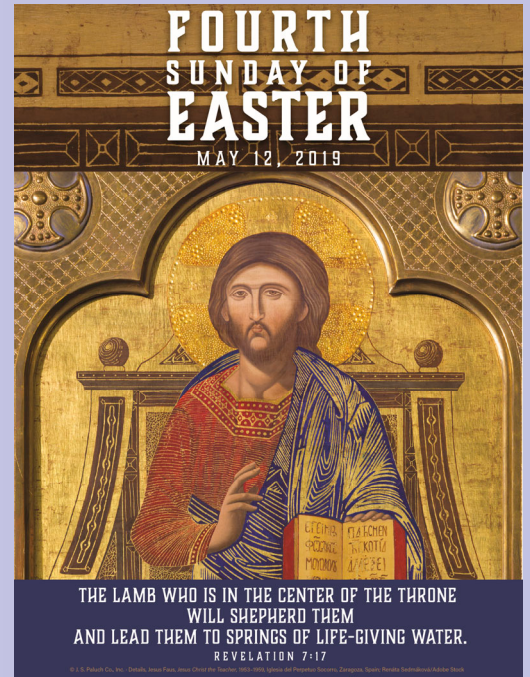

Modern culture has done a lot to erode away many of our traditions as well as decency and reverence. Although the Catholic Church has no real dress code for proper attire when attending Mass, there IS an unwritten dress code that demands we are properly dressed out of respect, honor and reverence for the Real Presence of Our Lord. Unfortunately, today a lot of people seem to forget they are attending church for the Sacred and Solemn Celebration of the Mass, and they seem to think that they are going to a fashion show, with the church aisle as their own personal catwalk. When you dress for Mass, you are not dressing to impress others, you are dressing for God. In addition, just the very act of dressing up nicely and modestly for Mass makes children more inclined to behave better during Mass. There are TWO main reasons one should dress modestly and decently for Mass: Out of respect and reverence for God In order not to be a distraction or stumbling block to our fellow parishioners.

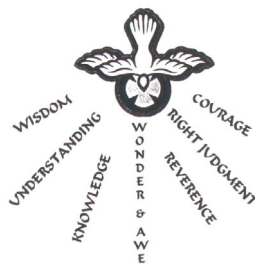
