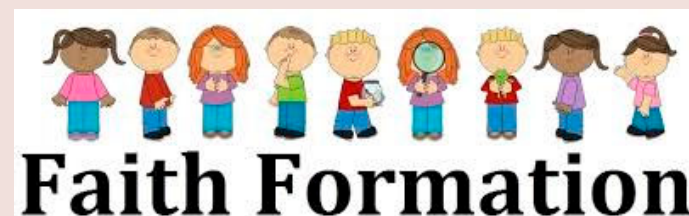

## Youth Group

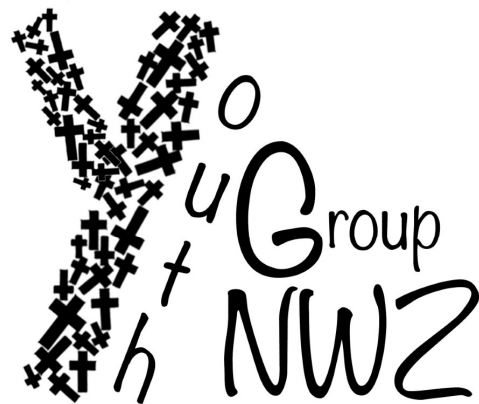
