Exaltation of the Holy Cross

September 14

Early in the fourth century, Saint Helena, mother of the Roman Emperor Constantine, went to Jerusalem in search of the holy places of Christ's life. She razed the second-century Temple of Aphrodite, which tradition held was built over the Savior's tomb, and her son built the Basilica of the Holy Sepulcher on that spot. During the excavation, workers found three crosses. Legend has it that the one on which Jesus died was identified when its touch healed a dying woman.

The cross immediately became an object of veneration. At a Good Friday celebration in Jerusalem toward the end of the fourth century, according to an eyewitness, the wood was taken out of its silver container and placed on a table together with the inscription Pilate ordered placed above Jesus' head: Then "all the people pass through one by one; all of them bow down, touching the cross and the inscription, first with their foreheads, then with their eyes; and, after kissing the cross, they move on."

To this day, the Eastern Churches, Catholic and Orthodox alike, celebrate the Exaltation of the Holy Cross on the September anniversary of the basilica's dedication. The feast entered the Western calendar in the seventh century after Emperor Heraclius recovered the cross from the Persians, who had carried it off in 614, 15 years earlier. According to the story, the emperor intended to carry the cross back into Jerusalem himself, but was unable to move forward until he took off his imperial garb and became a barefoot pilgrim.

Our Lady of Sorrows

15

September

For a while there were two feasts in honor of the Sorrowful Mother: one going back to the 15th century, the other to the 17th century. For a while both were celebrated by the universal Church: one on the Friday before Palm Sunday, the other in September.

The principal biblical references to Mary's sorrows are in Luke 2:35 and John 19:26-27. The Lucan passage is Simeon's prediction about a sword piercing Mary's soul; the Johannine passage relates Jesus' words from the cross to Mary and to the beloved disciple.

Many early Church writers interpret the sword as Mary's sorrows, especially as she saw Jesus die on the cross. Thus, the two passages are brought together as prediction and fulfillment.

Saint Ambrose in particular sees Mary as a sorrowful yet powerful figure at the cross. Mary stood fearlessly at the cross while others fled. Mary looked on her Son's wounds with pity, but saw in them the salvation of the world. As Jesus hung on the cross, Mary did not fear to be killed, but offered herself to her persecutors.

Saint Cyprian of Carthage

September 16

One of the first great theologians in the church, this Latin father is remembered today for his writings, which are quoted in the documents of the Second Vatican Council. A late convert, Thascius Cecilianus Cyprianus was a lawyer, rhetorician, and teacher before being chosen by the people of the clergy of Carthage, in North Africa, as their bishop. He was drawn into papal controversies and schisms, but he was also known for pastoral zeal and aiding plague victims. Having survived one Roman persecution, he later was beheaded for refusing to participate in state religious ceremonies. He wrote biblical commentary and treatises on church unity and the sacraments.



Faith Formation

- All Faith Formation classes that are on Sunday will be from 10:15-11:15 AM. This will allow sufficient time to attend either the 9:00 AM Mass or the 11:30 AM Mass should you choose too.
 - All Faith Formation classes that are on Wednesday will be from 7:00-8:00 PM.
 - All students should be wearing masks upon arrival. They will have their temperature checked as they enter the building and will have hand sanitizer sprayed on their hands. Each classroom will have an air sanitizer and ionizer in it. (Identical to the ones we have been using in the church). Each class will be asked to wipe down tables and chairs before leaving to keep everything sanitized.
 - Please drop off and pick up your students on time!!
 - Classes for Faith Formation will begin in October. Only those students who are preparing for sacrament reception will be attending in person classes this fall. That is first and second grades preparing for First Communion and sixth and seventh grades preparing for Confirmation. In addition to these students, any student who is behind on sacrament reception will also be attending in person classes.
 - All other students will have access to an online program that will be available at www.catholicbrain.com, we will have more information on that coming soon.

Se le pedirá a cada clase que limpie las mesas y sillas antes de salir para mantener todo desinfectado.

 - * Las clases de formación en la fe comenzarán en Octubre. Solo aquellos estudiantes que se estén preparando para la recepción sacramental asistirán a clases en persona este otoño. Eso es primero y segundo grados preparándose para la Primera Comunión y sexto y séptimo grados preparándose para la Confirmación. Además de estos estudiantes, cualquier estudiante que esté atrasado en la recepción sacramental también asistirá a clases en persona.
 - * Todos los demás estudiantes tendrán acceso al programa en línea que estará disponible en www.catholicbrain.com, pronto tendremos más información al respecto.
