Saint Jose Sanchez del Rio

José was born in 1913 in Sahuayo, Michoacán, México. He was the third of four children. José loved his faith and grew up with a strong devotion to Our Lady of Guadalupe. When José was twelve years old, the Cristero Wars began in Mexico. During this period in history the Mexican government attempted to extinguish the influence of the Catholic Church throughout the country. It persecuted the Catholic Church by seizing property, closing religious schools and convents, and executing Catholic priests. In defense of the Church, the peasants of many of the central and western states in Mexico rebelled against the government. Even though he was too young to join the rebellion, José desperately wanted to be a Cristero and stand up for his faith. He begged his mother saying, "Mama, do not let me lose the opportunity to gain Heaven so easily and so soon." He was eventually allowed to join the effort as a flag bearer. During a battle José was captured and was asked to deny his faith and the Cristero cause. José refused and was tortured terribly. Refusing to renounce his faith angered the government soldiers so much that they cut off the bottom of his feet. As José was forced to walk through town, he recited the rosary, prayed for his enemies, sang songs to Our Lady of Guadalupe, and proclaimed, "I will never give in. Vivo Cristo Rey y Santa Maria de Guadalupe!" We celebrate the feast day of Saint José on February 10th and pray for his intercession on behalf of all persecuted Christians and children.

Our icon we have on the cover this weekend is hung in our chapel and was hand done by an artist in Mexico. It was donated by Lisa Trejo in memory of Marvin Trejo. Thank you Lisa, for this most generous gift to our parish.

San José Sánchez del Río

José nació en 1913 en Sahuayo, Michoacán, México. Era el tercero de cuatro hijos. José amaba su fe y creció con una fuerte devoción a Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe. Cuando José tenía doce años, comenzaron las Guerras Cristeras en México. Durante este período de la historia, el gobierno mexicano intentó extinguir la influencia de la Iglesia Católica en todo el país. Persiguió a la Iglesia católica confiscando propiedades, cerrando escuelas religiosas y conventos y ejecutando sacerdotes católicos. En defensa de la Iglesia, los campesinos de muchos de los estados del centro y oeste de México se rebelaron contra el gobierno. A pesar de que era demasiado joven para unirse a la rebelión, José deseaba desesperadamente ser cristero y defender su fe. Le rogó a su madre diciendo: "Mamá, no dejes que pierda la oportunidad de ganarme el cielo tan fácilmente y tan pronto". Finalmente se le permitió unirse al esfuerzo como abanderado. Durante una batalla, José fue capturado y se le pidió que negara su fe y la causa cristera. José se negó y fue torturado terriblemente. Negarse a renunciar a su fe enfureció tanto a los soldados del gobierno que le cortaron la planta de los pies. Cuando José se vio obligado a caminar por la ciudad, recitó el rosario, oró por sus enemigos, cantó canciones a Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe y proclamó: "Nunca me rendiré. ¡Vivo Cristo Rey y Santa María de Guadalupe!" Celebramos la fiesta de San José el 10 de febrero y rezamos por su intercesión en nombre de todos los cristianos y niños perseguidos.

Nuestro ícono que tenemos en la portada este fin de semana está colgado en nuestra capilla y fue hecho a mano por un artista en México. Fue donada por Lisa Trejo en memoria de Marvin Trejo. Gracias Lisa, por este generoso regalo a nuestra parroquia.
