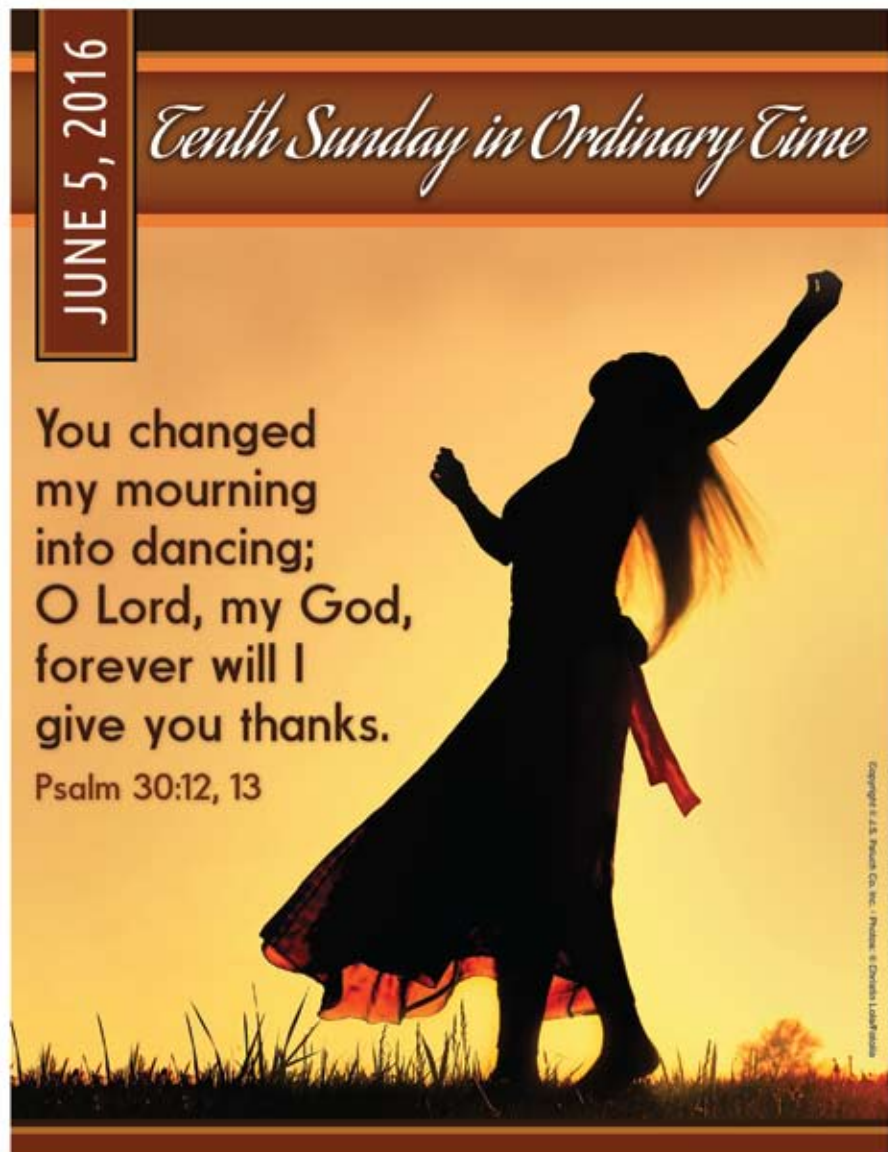

## DEAR PARISHIONERS OF ST. ANTHONY OF PADUA CHURCH & ANNUNCIATION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY CHURCH,

**Reviewing the Sacrament of Holy Orders**  
As we welcome Deacon Chris Cambre with us on Notre Dame Seminary's Parish Internship Program, I review what the **Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church** summaries

on some aspects of the sacrament of Holy Orders. Please note that the "# ..." following the question refers to the paragraph in the Catechism of the Catholic Church:

**322. What is the sacrament of Holy Orders?** [# 1536] It is the sacrament through which the mission entrusted by Christ to his apostles continues to be exercised in the Church until the end of time.

**323. Why is this sacrament called Holy Orders?** [# 1537-1538] Orders designates an ecclesial body into which one enters by means of a special consecration (ordination). Through a special gift of the Holy Spirit, this sacrament enables the ordained to exercise a sacred power in the name and with the authority of Christ for the service of the People of God.

**325. What are the degrees that make up the sacrament of Holy Orders?** [# 1554, 1593] The sacrament of Holy Orders is composed of three degrees which are irreplaceable for the organic structure of the Church: the episcopate, the presbyterate and the diaconate.

**326. What is the effect of episcopal ordination?** [# 1557-1558] Episcopal ordination confers the fullness of the sacrament of Holy Orders. It makes the bishop a legitimate successor of the apostles and integrates him into the episcopal college to share with the Pope and the other bishops care for all the churches. It confers on him the offices of teaching, sanctifying, and ruling.

**328. What is the effect of ordination to the priesthood?** [# 1562-1567, 1595] The anointing of the Spirit seals the priest with an indelible, spiritual character that configures him to Christ the priest and enables him to act in the name of Christ the Head. As a co-worker of the order of bishops he is consecrated to preach the Gospel, to celebrate divine worship, especially the Eucharist from which his ministry draws its strength, and to be a shepherd of the faithful.

**330. What is the effect of the ordination to the diaconate?** [# 1569-1571, 1596] The deacon, configured to Christ the servant of all, is ordained for service to the Church. He carries out this service under the authority of his proper bishop by the ministry of the Word, of divine worship, of pastoral care and of charity.

### An Introduction by Deacon Chris Cambre

I was born and raised in Lafayette. I was homeschooled up till High School and attended Teurlings for three years and

finished my last year at John Paul the Great Academy. I then went on to Seminary attending St. Ben's in Covington. After a few years there I went up to Washington, D.C. to get a licentiate degree in Philosophy at the Catholic University of America. I am currently finishing my theological studies at Notre Dame Seminary in New Orleans. I am looking forward to serving at St. Anthony and Annunciation. I ask that you pray for me that I may be a good and faithful servant of the Lord.

### Gospel for the Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, Cycle C – Luke 7:11-17

A survey of the Gospels reveals many ways in which Jesus upheld the dignity of women. In a culture where women were considered second-class citizens, Jesus was never afraid to encounter women, to affirm them, and to welcome them among his followers. Here we see that his heart was stirred by the situation of this grieving mother. The man who had died was "the only son of his mother, and she was a widow." In this culture, her father, her husband, or her son protected a woman. Absent one of those men in her life, she was in an incredibly vulnerable position. This, along with the grief of losing her child, struck the Lord with pity. Then, he did the impossible and restored the dead man to life. After "the dead man sat up ... Jesus gave him to his mother." Jesus made a point to restore and affirm this woman's vocation as a mother. Christ himself reveals, through this ministry to this mother, that her role is vital. May we also find ways to affirm and serve the mothers in our midst.

**Luke 7:11-17:** Luke tells us that "fear seized" the people who saw Jesus raise the widow's son from the dead. What do you think they were afraid of?

**1 Kings 17:17-24:** On what grounds does Elijah question God?

**Galatians 1:11-19:** What do you imagine Paul and Peter (Cephas) talked about during their fifteen days together in Jerusalem?
