

# Plant and Seed Swap

**When:** Sunday, April 25, immediately following worship

**Where:** the covered entrance to the church facing Gordon Street

**How to participate:** Bring your potted plant, seeds, or plant starts to swap with others. There is NO CHARGE for this fun event. Just bring plants/seeds and take home new ones.

## A few rules:

- Bring only healthy plants – check for pests or wilt
- Bring only current seeds – check that expiration date
- Please label what you bring. If you know growing requirements, add that to the label as well. *If the plant has poisonous parts, we have to know that!*
- Remember that kids like to garden, too. Consider bringing some easily grown plants or seeds for them.
- Bring your own boxes or bags for carrying your treasures home. We aren't providing those.
- Bring all plants, starts, and seeds to the covered entrance BEFORE worship. Our volunteers will organize everything for the swap that follows worship.

A special craft has been designed by Beth Morris to go along with this event. Once you've completed your craft, please bring it back to the church the following Sunday for display. This craft has been thoughtfully designed for ages 2-100.
