Hope

The eye at the top of the windows represents the All Provident God whose concern encompasses all of Creation, as depicted by the rays bursting forth. The anchor, a traditional symbol of Hope, reminds us that we can anchor ourselves and become firmly attached to the Church, signified by the ship at the bottom. The rainbow signifies the Covenant that exists between God and man.
