## ***Sorrowful Mysteries—The Scourging at the Pillar***

The pillar, rope, and scourge symbolize the suffering of our Lord, and the rooster reminds us of Peter's denial.

Reflections:

*At that he began to curse and to swear, "I do not know the man." And immediately a cock crowed. Then Peter remembered the word that Jesus had spoken: "Before the cock crows you will deny me three times." He went out and began to weep bitterly. **Matthew 26:74-75***

*He began to curse and to swear, "I do not know this man about whom you are talking." and immediately a cock crowed a second time. Then Peter remembered the word that Jesus had said to him, "Before the cock crows twice you will deny me three times." He broke down and wept. **Mark 14:71-72***

*But Peter said, "My friend, I do not know what you are talking about." Just as he was saying this, the cock crowed, and the Lord turned and looked at Peter, and Peter remembered the word of the Lord, how he had said to him, "Before the cock crows today, you will deny me three times." He went out and began to weep bitterly. **Luke 22:60-62***

*Now Simon Peter was standing there keeping warm. And they said to him, "You are not one of his disciples, are you?" He denied it and said, "I am not." One of the slaves of the high priest, a relative of the one whose ear Peter had cut off, said, "Didn't I see you in the garden with him?" Again Peter denied it. And immediately the cock crowed. **John 18:25-27***

*Then he released Barabbas to them, but after he had Jesus scourged, he handed him over to be crucified. **Matthew 27:26***

*So Pilate, wishing to satisfy the crowd, released Barabbas to them and, after he had Jesus scourged, handed him over to be crucified. **Mark 15:15***

*The men who held Jesus in custody were ridiculing and beating him. They blindfolded him and questioned him, saying, "Prophesy! Who is it that struck you?" And they reviled him in saying many other things against him. **Luke 22:63-64***
