The Glorious Mysteries—The Descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles

The form of the dove symbolizes the gentleness with which the Holy Spirit works in our souls. The fiery tongues represent zeal, fervor, and the illumination of the mind. Mary's presence among the Apostles is shown by the monogram at the lower left.
