

Sacred Heart Church--Stained Glass Windows

The magnificent eighteen stained-glass windows which surround the upper half of Sacred Heart Church depict the three virtues of Faith, Charity and Hope and the fifteen decades of the Rosary. They were designed by Heinz Reuters of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, and crafted by Reinarts Art Studio in Winona, Minnesota.

There are three windows between each of the six majestic pillars in the church. The following diagram identifies the location of each window listed below. Most of the windows were installed in a clockwise direction. Note, however, the windows numbered fourteen through eighteen were installed counter-clockwise.
