Congratulations to the 2016 – 2017 Algebra Class!

Our Advanced Math Students in Grade 8 took High School Algebra during the 2016-2017 school year. Before graduation, these students are required to take the Florida State End-of-Course (EOC) test for high school credit and to qualify for advancement to their next level of high school math regardless of the high school they attend. The state requires an EOC assessment score of 3 as a passing grade. 100% of our 8th graders who took Algebra I EOC passed the High School course (compared with Florida's average of 62% passing), and 75% of these students received a score of 5 which is the highest mastery level score given by the state! Congratulations to all of these students who worked hard throughout the year, and thank you to Mrs. Owens who is dedicated to teaching our Middle School Math classes
