Little Flowers Girls Club
St. Joseph Catholic School



We are so excited to announce that St. Joseph Catholic School has formed its very own Little Flowers Girls' Club ® for grades Kindergarten through Fifth Grade!

The Little Flowers Girls' Club ® is a Catholic club for girls that teaches virtues through scripture, saints' biographies and the Catechism of the Catholic Church. It has been around for over 25 years and consists of four years of study: Wreaths I, II, III and IV. Each of the first three Wreaths of study consists of nine virtues each. Like a scouting program, girls earn badges for the virtues they have practiced and the life skills they have learned. But unlike most scouting organizations, the girls learn

and earn their badges through a distinctly Catholic lens. This Catholic to the Core program relies on the stories of the saints, Sacred Scripture and the Catechism of the Catholic Church.

Our meetings will be held twice a month on Wednesdays at St. Joseph Catholic School from 3:00 pm to 4:30pm. We will open our weekly meetings with a prayer, enjoy an after-school snack, virtue discussion/activity, sing a song or two, create a craft and close with a prayer. The initial fee to join is \$30. This will cover the cost and shipping fees for the new member kit, which includes a sash, 10 badges, a club cross patch and a Member's Guide book. The monthly membership dues are \$10 and will be used to cover the cost of craft and snack supplies, as well as club outings that we will have. We will be performing community service projects, which will be made possible through our fundraising efforts. Our first meeting will take place on September 6th and we hope you will join us! If interested, please fill out the attached form, enclose your \$45 payment via check made payable to St. Joseph Catholic School and drop in the Little Flowers box in the main office before August 15th. This timeframe will allow time for ordering and delivery of new member supplies in time for our first meeting.
