# A message from Fr. Bill

## Bazaar Results

First and foremost, a huge THANK YOU to everyone who helped make this year's Bazaar a success!!! Many people (nearly 200) worked together in order to bring success to this year's event. Also a special thanks to Sandy Fritze, and Ken Choquette and crew for all their hard work! We have received invoices or contacted all our vendors, so we have just about all the expenses. Here are the preliminary results:

Income	\$ 45,696.55
Expenses	\$(27,669.81) Approximate but very close
Cathedraticum 7.5%	\$(1,352.01)
Giving 10%	\$(1,802.67)
Dollars we can use	\$ 14,872.06 Approximate profit – slightly higher than 2016

It has been a practice of this parish to give away 10% of the net income to community programs and in some cases to our own parish programs. Cathedraticum is a tax the diocese assess all parishes, it is the way the dioceses is able to have money to operate. All parishes pay 7.5% of all donations to the diocese; this is not optional but obligatory.

If anyone has any questions about the income, expenses, giving, or cathedraticum, please do not hesitate to ask me, I would be happy to address any concerns, questions, or supportive comments☺.
