All *Covid 19 Safety Measures* will be in place. Call the office and let us know if you will help that day so that we may plan accordingly. **Fall cleanup will begin soon. Patrons are asked to remove any of the following items before Nov. 1st:** spring/summer flowers, faded or broken plastic flowers and mementos as well as tattered patriot flags. Real pumpkins also need to be removed because they will freeze and cause unwanted critters.
We will not remove any Fall decorations unless stated above.

Please wear a mask that covers your nose and mouth while attending Mass.
 Enter the church through the front entrance on Church St. or use the elevator if needed. **Follow instructions from the ushers for seating, when receiving communion and for exiting the church.** Baskets are located at the exits of the church for offering envelopes & donations. The church and the bathrooms are cleaned after each Mass.
NO SOCIAL GATHERINGS are allowed before or after Masses. We are safer together if everyone follows the rules.
