 On March 16, 2020 Bishop McManus announced his decision to suspend the obligation to take part in the Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation due to the specific danger presented by this virus to older people and those with certain health conditions. Due to the increased spread of the Covid-19 Virus, Bishop McManus has made the decision to continue that suspension until the First Sunday of Lent, February 21, 2021.
