**We will work between the hours of 9 am—3 pm. Any time you can give to help is appreciated.**

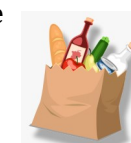
Lunch & beverages will be provided. Please bring your own rake, work gloves, & leaf blower. Students can use this time to meet community service hours.
