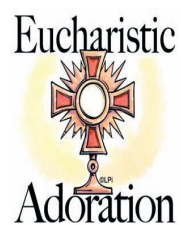

Coming Home to Mass

With the lifting of most pandemic gathering restrictions last week, Bishop McManus has announced the restoration of the obligation to take part in Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation, effective this Sunday, June 6, 2021 the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

Bishop McManus has also modified those adaptations of liturgical practices which we have been observing for the past year in mitigation of the virus. As of Saturday, May 29th, masks and social distancing are no longer required of all parishioners. However, **per CDC guidelines, non-vaccinated persons are still encouraged to wear masks and maintain social distancing.** The tape has been removed, therefore, from all but a portion of the church. Social distancing pews are along both side walls of the church.



This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Please join us after the 10:15 am Mass in procession to our Marian Shrine. We will have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament followed by Benediction. The First Communion students and their families are invited to join us for Benediction on this special day after they receive their First Holy Communion.
