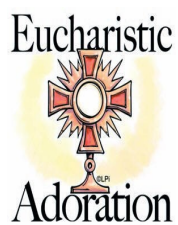

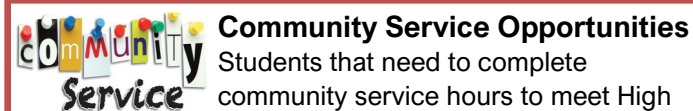
8 am Mass followed by Exposition and Adoration with Benediction at 12 noon.
