SECRETARY'S REPORT: A brief financial overview. Last month we had to draw \$1,000 out of savings to pay the shortfall on the month's bills. This month, we are \$150 in the red so far on paying the bills. Tapping into savings is worry some as we are expecting the steeple bill to be near \$100,000 due to underlying damage needing repairs. Also we are getting 14 windows replaced in the school building that were broken in a hail storm. The steeple work was delayed initially due to lack of funds.
