We pray that they communicate clearly, truthfully, and calmly

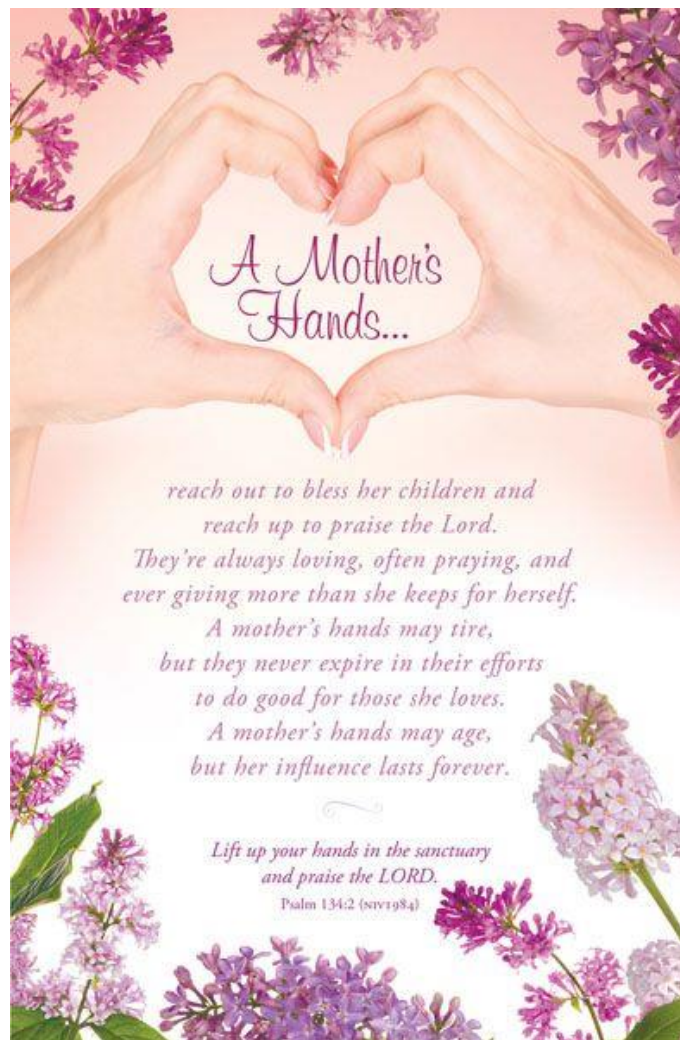
