

THEO 4881 Accompanying Youth and Young Adults on their Journey (1 credit hour): Instructed by Rick Smith. Like the disciples on the road to Emmaus, young people are filled with questions. They want someone to walk with them in their questioning. This class shares paths of accompaniment. *This course is one of the 1 hour courses that may be used to obtain the Diocesan Certification in Youth Ministry. Classes are four Wednesday evenings from 6:00 to 9:30 pm on Aug. 26, Sept. 2, Oct. 7, Nov. 4.

THEO 3053 Sacramental Theology (3 credit hours): Instructor by Fr. Frank Coady. The class is a study of the theological and spiritual underpinnings of the liturgy, with specific application to each sacrament. Most of the course will focus on the Eucharist. *This course is one of the 3 hour courses that may be used to obtain the Diocesan Certification in Liturgical Ministry or Youth Ministry. Classes are Saturday mornings from 8:30 am to 12 noon on Sept. 19, 26, Oct. 3, 10, 17, 24, 31 Nov. 7, 14.
