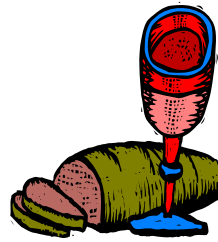

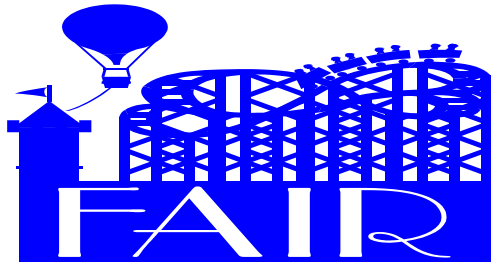
SJV Track Club Relay Medal Count: 7 Gold, 2 Silver, and 11 Bronze!!

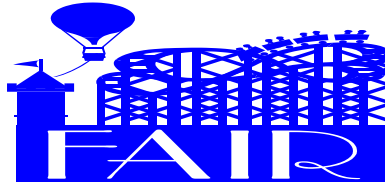
