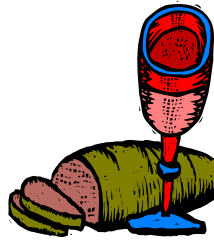

St. John Vianney School News

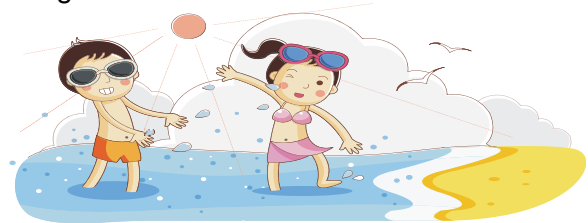

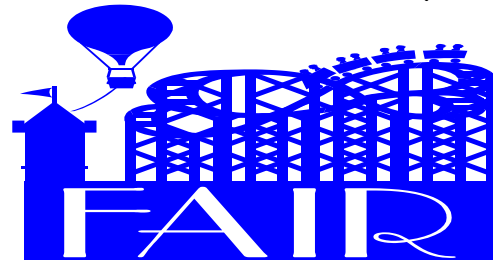

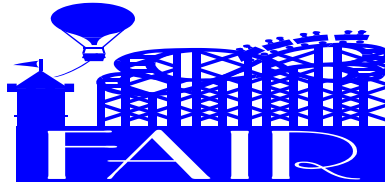
