Requirements: registration in parish, baptism preparation class, arrangements are made at least 3 MONTHS prior to the date of the baptism. Sponsors and Christian witnesses need verification of belonging to a Church.

Anointing of the Sick: anyone who is ill and or would like to receive Communion is asked to call the rectory.

Marriage: Couples planning marriage must notify the Parish Rectory at least ONE YEAR in advance for date and necessary info. Pre-Cana classes and F.O.C.C.U.S. Program etc. are required. At least one party must be a registered member of this parish.

**Parish Membership**

All new families who live within our boundaries are welcome to the parish. They are requested to register at the rectory. If a parishioner is not registered, it is difficult for us to issue testimonial letters, recommendations, references, etc. When you move or change your address please notify the rectory beforehand. 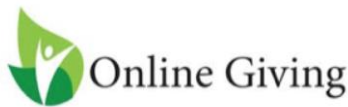

**Saint of the Week:  
 St. Frances Xavier Cabrini**



St. Frances grew up in Italy, and at the age of 24 began teaching at an orphanage. After working in the orphanage for a few years she founded the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart. Under the instruction of Pope Leo XIII, she and her fellow sisters traveled to New York City to work with Italian immigrants. Instead of working at previously established orphanages in America, St. Frances founded her own. Within 35 years she founded 67 different institutions dedicated to helping and caring for the sick, poor and uneducated. In 1946, St. Frances became the first American citizen to become canonized as a Saint. May we look to St. Frances as a beacon of love, light and kindness, and strive us to live a life of compassion and service as she did.

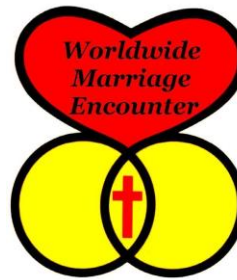
