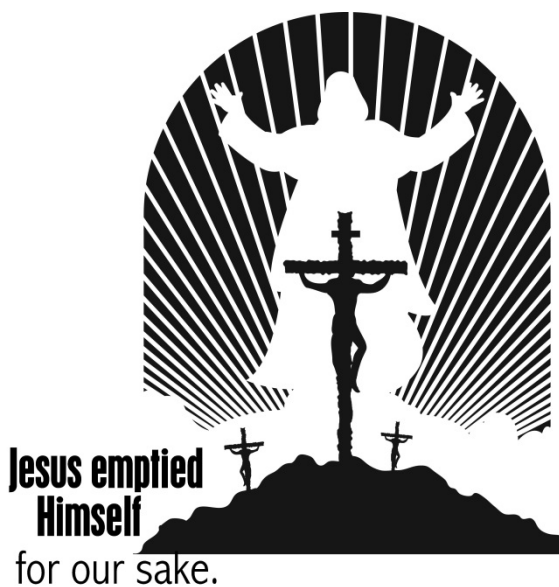

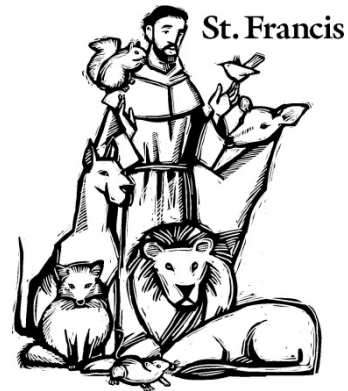

October is the Month of the Rosary

October is an important month for our Archdiocese. The Consecration of the Archdiocese to the Immaculate Heart of Mary will be on October 7 – Feast of the Holy Rosary – in the cathedral.

October is also a Respect Life month. For the entire month, the members of Our Lady of Perpetual Help Novena Group will dedicate every “Hail Mary” of the Rosary for the intention of an innocent unborn. The inspiration for this devotion comes from the message from Jesus given to a visionary, Maureen Sweeney-Kyle from Ohio on February 28, 2005:

“I am your Jesus, born incarnate.”

“What my mother told you last night concerning the Rosary of the Unborn is this. If a group is gathered who are praying for the unborn from the heart and only one person has in their possession the Rosary of the Unborn. I will honor each ‘Hail Mary’ from each person in the group as if they were holding the Rosary of the Unborn themselves.”

“In this way I lift the constraint of time which it takes to produce enough rosaries.”

A follower of this devotion, a parishioner of the Church of Epiphany gave us an alternative ring rosary which we could use for this purpose. (I found out that two of our novena members already owned this specially designed rosary.) If you wish to join the prayers for the unborn, please join us on Fridays at 4:00 – 5:10 p.m. in the Parish Center Chapel.
