Paul warned the Corinthians of the shortness of time because the world is passing away. They should, therefore, conduct themselves accordingly.

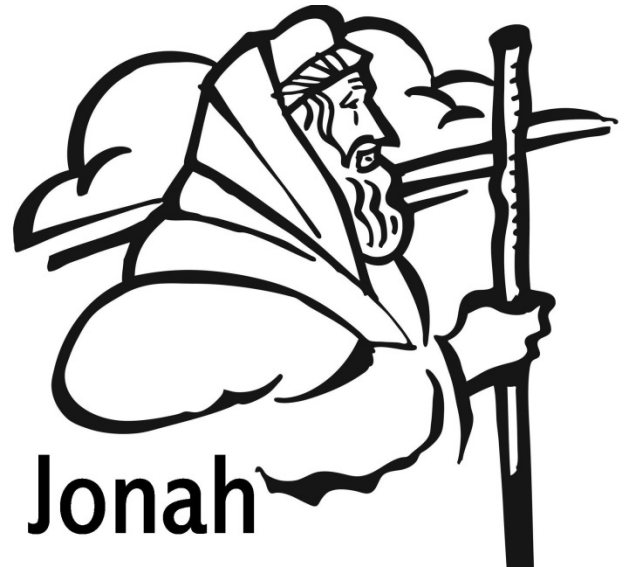
Gospel: Mark 1:14-20

El tema del llamado del Señor continúa, aunque de una manera distinta. Tanto en el Antiguo Testamento como en el Evangelio, Dios hace una invitación urgente para que los que la escuchen respondan de inmediato. Dios llama porque hay una necesidad que exige la atención de uno o de varios pastores. En el caso de Ninive, fue Jonás quien respondió ese llamado; los habitantes de la ciudad se convirtieron e hicieron ayuno y penitencia para evitar la destrucción de la ciudad. En el Evangelio, Jesús se dirige directamente a los pescadores y los llama: "Siganme y haré de ustedes pescadores de hombres" (Marcos 1, 17). Esa urgencia también se percibe en las palabras de san Pablo, quien afirma que la vida es corta y transitoria y que, por lo tanto, a todos les importa vivir en el Señor y no del mundo. La Iglesia nos llama a cambiar radicalmente hacia Jesucristo para disfrutar serenamente de su misericordia y así poder reconocerlo en nuestro prójimo cercano. De nuevo, las Sagradas Escrituras invitan a una reflexión con aquellos que se preparan para la iniciación cristiana en nuestras comunidades y con nuestros ministros y servidores laicos.

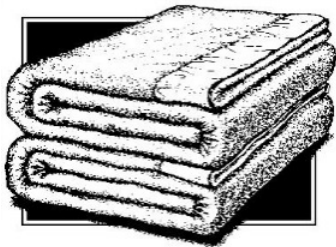


Pot O'Gold Raffle
