Reflexiones Pastorales de Rdo. Juan J. Sosa **(Oregon Catholic Press)**

Indiscutible, en esta vida no se puede complacer a todo el mundo. Es importantísimo, sin embargo, que nos dispongamos a servir a los demás como respuesta de fe a la llamada que Dios nos hace y según nuestros medios y recursos. Esta verdad hoy surge para nosotros de las lecturas dominicales. En la primera, el pueblo le reclama a Moisés su vida pasada en Egipto ante las vicisitudes que experimentan en su travesía hacia la tierra prometida; el pueblo se queja porque en esta travesía que los hace libres, sienten hambre. Jesús en el Evangelio le reclama al pueblo por qué lo persiguen tanto: ¿quieren ver signos y prodigios solamente? ¿En que se basa la fe de tantos seguidores?

Sus propios discípulos lo cuestionan, y él dirige sus pensamientos, hacia el don del Padre que les da el verdadero pan del cielo. El Evangelio concluye, por fin, con una hermosa petición: sus seguidores quieren de Jesús ese pan de la vida que los conduce hacia la eternidad. En ese mismo contexto, san Pablo exhorta a su audiencia en la carta a los Efesios a dejar a un lado su antigua forma de vivir para abrazarse de lleno a la vida nueva que han descubierto en Cristo, el Señor, el verdadero pan del cielo. Hoy, la Palabra proyecta de nuevo el dilemma entre la fe y la desconfianza en nuestra jornada diaria. Para la oracion personal o el dialogo comunitario, importa mucho que reflexionemos sobre este dilema. Muchos afirman que estas quejas no deben existir entre aquellos que comparte un mismo bautismo y se nutren de la Eucaristía. No obstante, la queja forma parte de nuestra humanidad. Lo que importa es la forma en que lidiamos con las “quejas” y los medios que fortalecen nuestra fe en el Señor, para ayudarle a sembrar la verdadera paz que el mundo anhela.

USCCB Novena for the Legal Protection of Human Life 8/3-9/28

The USCCB Committee on Pro-Life Activities is initiating a Novena for the Legal Protection of Human Life. This nine-week effort will include prayer and fasting for the intention that the change in the membership of the Supreme Court will move our nation closer to the day when every human being is protected in law and welcomed in life. The Novena will also include materials to help educate the public about how Roe v. Wade is not health care, is bad law, and fails women.

The Novena takes place from Friday, August 3, to Friday, September 28. Individuals are urged to sign up for the Novena as part of the USCCB Call to Prayer at usccb.org/pray. Those who sign up will receive weekly email or text message reminders to pray and fast along with a fact

about Roe to share with others including their two U.S. senators (through NCHLA/Human Life

Action). Cardinal Dolan, chairman of the USCCB Committee on Pro-Life Activities issued a statement urging "all people of good will" to participate in this prayer and education effort. We ask that you please join Cardinal Dolan in promoting this Novena through all channels available to you.
