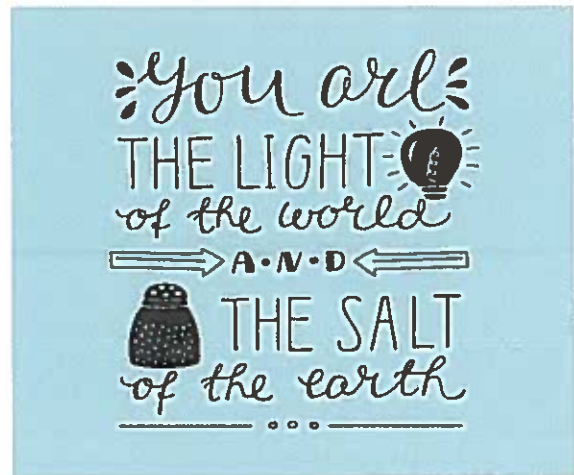
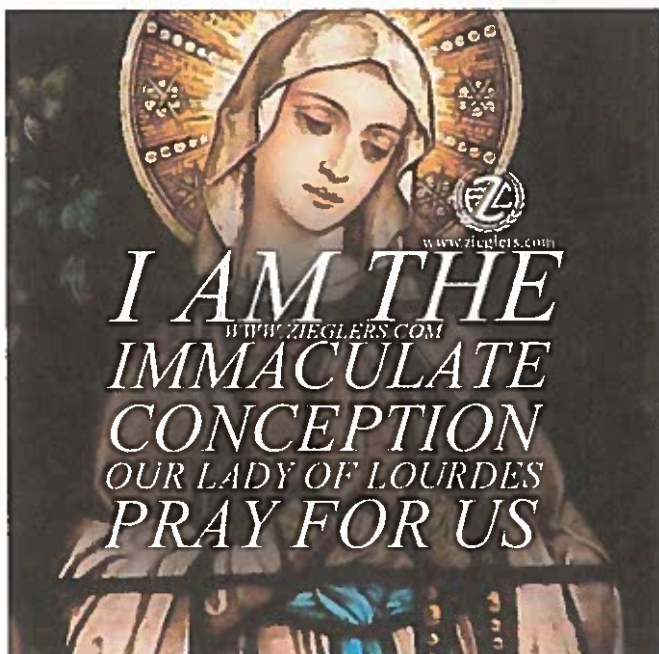

Jesus teaches that his disciples are to be the salt of the earth and the light of the world.

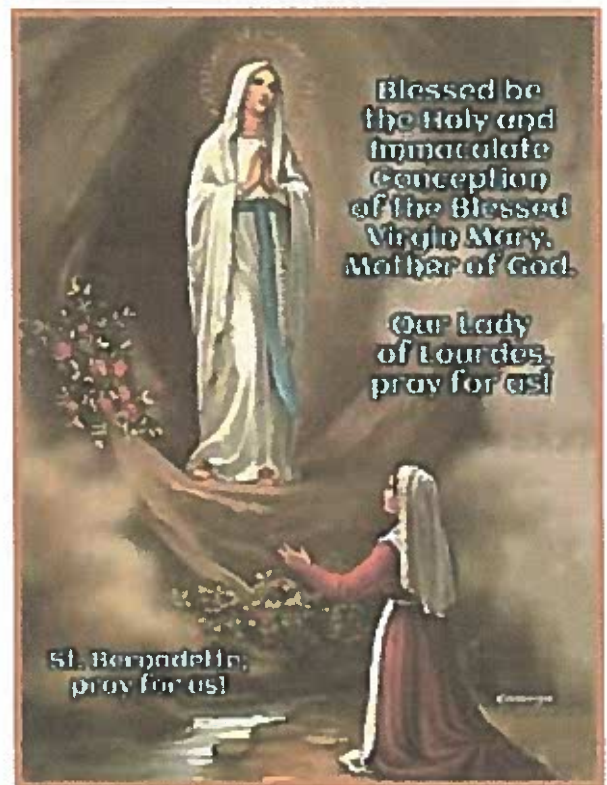
Background on the Gospel Reading

Following upon the teaching of the [Beatitudes](#), Jesus uses the now familiar metaphors of salt and light to describe the life of discipleship. We take salt and light for granted in our society, but these commodities were more precious in ancient cultures. Just as now, salt was used in Jesus' time for flavoring, as a preservative, and as a healing agent. Similarly, the widespread use of electricity in the modern world makes us less aware of the value and importance of light in our lives.

Still, our familiarity with this passage from Matthew's Gospel speaks well to the abiding

power of the imagery that Jesus presented. Jesus' call to be salt for the earth and light for the world powerfully states our mission as Church and as Christians. Our commitment to social justice flows from the exhortation that Jesus gives us in today's Gospel. Some of the activities that this commitment leads us to are given more concrete expression as the Corporal and Spiritual [Works of Mercy](#). When we feed the hungry, clothe the naked, console those who mourn, and so on, we show ourselves to be the salt of the earth and the light of the world. When we do these things with the community of faith, the Church, we are indeed acting as "a city set on a mountain" that cannot be hidden!-*Loyola Press*

REFLEXIÓN:

Primera Lectura – Del profeta Isaías. En esta lectura el profeta Isaías nos da consejos de como debe ser nuestro comportamiento para que tengamos frutos importantes en el mundo. Lo que el profeta nos dice es algo que ya nosotros hemos hecho como cristianos. Ayudar al desvalido, ser humilde con nuestro semejantes, etc. Solamente así brillará la luz en las tinieblas y nuestra oscuridad se volverá mediodía.

Segunda Lectura - Del apóstol San Pablo a los corintios. En esta lectura, Pablo manifiesta su humildad al confesar lo mucho que le costó predicar el Evangelio al pueblo de Corinto. El nunca quiso pasar por sabio ni deslumbrar a sus oyentes, sino que para llevar a cabo su misión usó un lenguaje sencillo y pudo lograrlo a través del poder del Espíritu.

Evangelio según San Mateo - El evangelio de hoy nos habla de dos conceptos de gran significado: Sal y Luz. La sal da sabor, la luz claridad. Jesús nos da una gran misión, que seamos sal y luz, nos manda a iluminar y a dar sabor. Pero no es nada fácil cuando vemos este mundo tan convulsionado, donde hay miseria, males que atacan a la humanidad provocando pánico, hacienda que el hombre pierda la esperanza. Cuando Jesús nos manda a ser luz, no es para que la guardemos, sino para que la pongamos en alto y de allí iluminar al mundo. No podemos ser luz solamente en la casa o iglesia, sino que en todo lugar donde este un cristiano. También nos pide ser sal, para que le demos sabor a la vida ante tantas dificultades. El mundo al que Cristo nos pide darle sabor e iluminación, esta cansado de teorías y promesas vanas.

Nuestra Iglesia debe ser luz y sal, iluminar y dar sabor.
