



Campus Minister for Liturgical Music

This position plans, coordinates and directs liturgical music for Campus Ministry. This position directs and manages the Chapel Choir and the Chapel Handbell Choir, plans and directs the liturgical music for regular services and large-scale University events, and provides resources to the student musicians who serve the residence hall chapels. This position collaborates with the University's Music Department and engages students, faculty, staff and alumni. Reporting to the Director of Campus Ministry, this position also assists with spiritual formation of students and pastoral care of the University community.

This is a full-time, 12-month, exempt position with benefits. Benefits include: medical & dental insurance, life insurance, long-term disability insurance, sick & vacation time, tuition remission benefits starting after 90 days (employee) or 2 years (spouse and children) of employment, retirement contributions after 2 years of employment, and eligibility for the University's home purchase assistance program consistent with program requirements. (Please note that eligibility for all University benefits is subject to applicable policies, practices, and requirements.)
