- Fish: **225 lbs.** -----Rocky, (Dock sea food) -----
 - Tartar: 4 containers (0.5 gal) ----- Rocky, (Dock sea food)-----
 - Hot Sauce---1 bottle-----**Sam's, (Jeff)**
 - Fries: **150 lbs.** (GFS 653921 Colossal Crisp) -----Nick S.
 - **Potatoes: 80 lbs.** -----Nick S.
 - Slaw: 14-gal----- using 100lbs cabbage, Cole slaw mix, making our own — Nick S.
 - Beans: 10-gal Stay with Vegetarian Baked Beans (Nick S.)
 - Bread: **20 loaves rye-1lb bags** and **10 loaves white, 10 loaves wheat**-----Steve P.
 - Ketchup: 4 containers (0.5 gal) **using squeeze bottles** -----Nick S.
 - Tea: big box from Sam's
 - Lemonade: 2 containers
 - Clam Chowder: **Making our own this year. 5 gallons**-----**Nick S.**
 - Sour cream/butter packets: 80 packets each
 - Paper products, napkins, plastic utensils: depends on remaining-----Jeff checking on it

- Start up cash; \$500.00 mostly \$250.00 ones, \$150.00 five's, and \$100.00 Ten's don't need twenties.
 - Menu Price stays the same this year.
 - Put up big road sign –in front of church-----Ron N.
 - Have Donna put an insert in bulletin a week prior to fish fry.
 - Have Jacobi gas station to put a notice on their sign the day of fish fry.
 - Bulletin Notice, local and other churches plus St Mary's school newsletter-----Ron N.
 - Check Burners to make sure all is well couple days prior (Nick S.)
 - Grind cabbage day before, put in sealed buckets put in frig till next day. Need a few clean tubs to mix slaw, and will send out email with time later. (Nick?)
 - Need to start at noon for all that can make it to get things rolling, by 2pm full speed.
 - If you can or cannot help please give us a heads up.
 - Bake potatoes prep starting at noon; wash and coat potatoes with veg oil, salt, pepper than bake at 500 degree for 30 minutes then put in cooler for at least 45 minutes to finish baking.
