March 21, 2019 Parish Council Meeting minutes reviewed and approved as written

We are discussing a directory for the church. Our last directory was in 2013, and 193 families were photographed. We currently have 409 families in the parish.

Special Guests: Bernie Wade-Universal Church Directories-Looking at doing a church directory. They have 3 versions to choose from with a directory. Standard, the first form allows for activity pages, roster and then photos of families. Ultimate-create your own where you design the activity, roster, and photos of families, with different versions of how the pages will look. Evolve is the last, and that is continually changing with updates regularly. They have an app as well that they could link from our page, or you can access from a smartphone. With any that we choose, the family receives 1 free 8 x 10 regardless of whether they purchase a picture package. Design team will meet with church, and help with design and organization, he estimates a 6-week period. Average picture packages are around \$70.

Dan Goben-Lifetouch-They have two programs. Standard, you can have as many pages upfront for activities. CC Program is a small directory, that is basically a throw away. They will come back and do another directory as we have 6 families added to the parish. He will do 3 updates in a 5-year program. He will give 20% off to all families if we sign up in next 4 weeks. 5 percent of total sales back to parish. One person is assigned to help us with the layout, and then 5 days for taking photos. They have a manual or link process for signing up to have your photo taken. He did not give me an average spend per family.

We will go over information and discuss at next parish council meeting.

Shanty Town was April 19th-20th at St. Mary of the Knobs. I had 7 attend from St. John Starlight. The youth participated in Silhouette Stations of the Cross, various service projects throughout the night, and an hour spent in the church with Jesus. 700 Easter eggs were filled for the Easter Sunday Egg Hunt at St. Mary of the Knobs, over 300 hot burritos were prepared and

delivered to the homeless, 50+ cardboard boxes were donated and used for shanties to sleep in, 47 care kits in zip lock bags were assembled for the homeless, 25 birthday cards and flowers were made for the nursing home, 18 pillow cases were decorated for youth at the shelter, 10 college care packages were assembled, 7 baby blankets were made, 4 pans of brownies and cookies were made for the Fire House, and 3 pet beds were made for the animal shelter. The youth may have gotten little sleep, but much fun was had!

The senior Mass and Breakfast were a success! The seniors did a great job participating in the liturgy and the breakfast was wonderful. We are so blessed to have so many willing to help out and pitch in.
