Faith Formation-August 2019

VBS was a huge success this year. We combined with St. Mary's of the Knobs and Starlight and had 44 children attend. It was very well received and many of the parents said they are definitely going to bring their children back next year.

Faith Formation will be resuming September 8. We will begin charging for the classes again this year, \$25 per student with a cap of \$75 per family. We will be using the same curriculum as last year with the Loyola Press Christ Our Life series for grades K-8. We will be combining grades 9-12 and using the Ascension Press program of Chosen: This Is Your Catholic Faith.

We will also be having Confirmation classes this year during Faith Formation about once a month, pulling out the Confirmation students to study separately using the Decision Point series by Matthew Kelly at Dynamic Catholic.

Jamie Schillmiller will get the food for Donuts for Santa and contact Santa about the day.

Men's Breakfast was a success and we will do it again with the men. Stephanie Willis will check dates with the men's group, so Spaghetti Dinner isn't the night before. This date is tentative. November 3, 2019. Sandy Jacobi and Connie Mefford will get the items for St. Anne's. We furnish Muffins, Coffee Cake, Juice, Fruit and Tea. Proceeds go to the Faith Formation Classes or our Youth Group.

Palm Sunday Breakfast is on April 5, 2020 between Masses from 9 AM till 10:30 AM. We will advertise the time change. Connie Mefford will contact Meijer's about the hams in November. We will ask for donated casseroles of egg and French toast. St. Anne's will buy the milk, juice, etc. Jamie will put this in the bulletin.

Second motion made by Sandy Jacobi and seconded by Loren Grahak: We need another parish organization to sponsor, be responsible and manage the yard sale because it is a great fundraiser for the parish. If no one steps up the yard sale is a no go for next year. This motion carried. The members don't want to see the yard sale cancelled.

New Purchase for the parish:

Motion was made by Rose Banet and Seconded by Linda Bentley that St. Anne's pay Jamie for our lunches. Everyone had a great time of fellowship and working for St. Anne's.

Motion made by Connie Mefford and seconded by Sandy Jacobi about us purchasing a griller for the kitchen like the one the men's club have, we will check on price and type, asking advice from the Men's Group.

Purchase another pot to heat water for Tea Drinkers motion made by Connie Mefford and seconded by Rose Banet. Motion carried for the purchase of an Electric Pot for hot water. Gayle Schrank will make a sign asking people to clean the pot after every use.

Gayle Schrank and Connie Mefford are checking into a field trip for St. Anne's to St. Meinard, scheduling the trip on the weekend so ladies who work will attend the trip. Day and dates determined by the events available.

We are checking into having Masses said for the ladies of the parish who have passed. It would cost St. Anne's \$10 Per Mass.

Linda Atherton is going to notify St. John's Starlight and St. Mary's of the Knobs about Ladies Day Out. We want them to feel welcome to our group for fellowship and community projects.
