## The Pastor's Page

Dear Friends of Our Lady of the Chesapeake,

Welcome to the middle of Summer! This July 15<sup>th</sup> is also the 15<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time. Our readings continue the theme of being a prophet for the Lord, of being chosen and sent out into the world to do the works of the Lord. As the Gospel indicates today, we have much to do and very little time. Jesus sent his disciples out, two by two, to all the towns and villages to preach repentance and to heal those in need. They are sent everywhere, but they are reminded not to waste their time. If towns reject them, then shake off the dust and move on to the next town. Sometimes we need the wisdom to do the same thing when it comes to our work as evangelizers and disciples. We should not look at it as a failure, but that instead, God has given us much more work to do. So, don't be afraid to go out and preach the loving mercy of God.

In consultation with the Finance Committee, OLC is looking for some people to help us with some pressing needs. One need is to re-establish a Fundraising Committee to develop and organize various means of fundraising for the Parish. This strategy is one way we are trying to stabilize our finances. We have some preliminary ideas we are trying to implement, but we need your help. If you enjoy organizing events or activities and would like to donate your time to our fundraising efforts, please see me after Mass or call the parish office.

OLC is also in need of a volunteer who is savvy with social media and can help us with our communication needs. In addition to the My Parish App, we also have access to a program called FLockNotes. Both are tools that allow us to keep you up to date on events at OLC. Your parish staff is maxed out, so in order for us to use these tools, we need your help. If you would like to volunteer, please see me after Mass or call the parish office.

I was asked to clarify the expense savings for parishioners to switch to GiveCentral. The average annual cost for envelopes is \$7.80/yr. Our bank gives us 225 free transactions per month. After that, we pay \$0.35 per transaction. We average around 1,000 transactions a month, mostly from check donations; therefore, we are paying \$271 a month to process your donation checks. If you write a check every week plus one second collection a month, the estimated cost to OLC to process your check donations is \$17.00. Add that to envelope costs and the total is almost \$25 a year. If you gave \$1,000/yr. through GiveCentral, the cost would be about \$20/yr., and would be reduced even more based on (1) more families signing up and (2) choosing to give monthly instead of weekly. So don't forget to sign up at [www.givecentral.org](http://www.givecentral.org).

Finally, stop by the Gathering Place and classrooms this weekend after all of the Masses to see the transformation done for OLC's Adventure Bible Camp (formerly VBS) happening this week. We are once again maxed out with 93 children, 51 teenage peers and 18 adults learning and sharing how Jesus saves us. Thank you for your support of this evangelization experience at OLC.

For the week of July 22<sup>nd</sup> through August 26<sup>th</sup>, we listen to the Gospel of John. There are three opportunities to understand the Sunday Readings expressed through the Evangelist, St. John. Come and explore how the Gospel is ever new to us!

This week our children will be participating in our Adventure Bible Camp. Miss Stacey and so many others have been preparing for this wonderful experience of faith for our children for months. **Shipwrecked with Jesus** is the theme of the week and the children will deepen their understanding of Jesus as a friend for all times. They will come to realize that Jesus rescues:

- When you're lonely
- When you worry
- When you struggle
- When you do wrong;
- When you're powerless

There is not a situation in life which Jesus cannot be the source of strength.

I am inviting you to consider being the presence of Jesus for someone who is "shipwrecked". Is there an adult you know who does not belong to any faith? Is there an adult you know who has not completed the sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Eucharist? 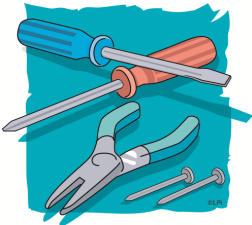
### Middle School Youth Ministry
