The Body and Blood of Christ, Week 12, Year C, El Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo, el año C del evangelio de San Lucas June / Junio 22-23, 2019

From Deacon John...

This day was called Corpus Christi, Latin for "the Body of Christ." Now, it is a more complete reflection of Eucharistic theology. Feeding 5,000, the only miracle in all four Gospels, is not the result of Jesus' compassion but is instigated by the disciples who wanted Jesus to send the crowd away. Instead Jesus tells the disciples to feed them on their own, a connection to the Eucharist when Jesus takes bread, looks up to heaven, blesses the bread, breaks it, and then gives it to the disciples. We are reminded that Jesus is doing more than feeding hungry people as was for the early Israelites. The bread he gives is his body, which he gives as often as the community breaks bread in remembrance of him in the Eucharist.

Este día se llamó Corpus Christi, latín para "el Cuerpo de Cristo". Ahora, es un reflejo más completo de la teología eucarística. Alimentando a 5,000. El único milagro en los cuatro evangelios, no es el resultado de la compasión de Jesús, sino que es instigado por los discípulos que querían que Jesús despidiera a la multitud. En cambio, Jesús les dice a los discípulos que los alimenten solos, una conexión con la Eucaristía cuando Jesús toma el pan, mira al cielo, bendice el pan, lo rompe y luego se lo da a los discípulos. Se recuerda a los lectores que Jesús está haciendo más que alimentar a personas hambrientas como lo fue para los primeros israelitas. El pan que él da es su cuerpo, el cual da tan a menudo como la comunidad lo rompe en memoria de él en la Eucaristía.

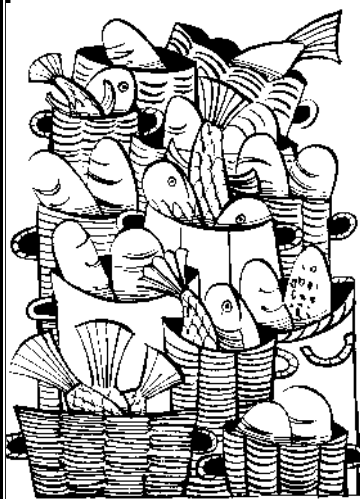

In historic shift, Vatican to consider married priests for Amazon region

VATICAN CITY (Reuters) A Vatican document on Monday said the Church should consider ordaining older married men as priests in remote areas of the Amazon, a historic shift

ies the possibility of conferring priestly ordination on elderly men, preferably indigenous, respected and accepted members of their communities," the document said.



It said such men could be ordained "even if they already have an established and stable family, in order to guarantee the sacraments that accompany and sustain Christian life.

"Only priests can say Mass or

which some say could pave the way for their use in other areas where clergy are scarce.

The recommendation, contained in a working document prepared by the Vatican for a synod of bishops from the Amazon scheduled for October, also called for some kind of "official ministry" for women in the area, although it did not elaborate. It was the most direct mention ever in a Vatican document of the possibility of a married priesthood, albeit limited, and a greater ministerial role for women in one area of the world.

The document spoke of the possibility of ordaining what are known as "viri probati", Latin for men of proven character, to deal with the shortage of priests. Men would be elderly, outstanding members of the local Catholic community with grown families.

"While affirming that celibacy is a gift for the Church, there have been requests that, for the most remote areas of the region, (the Church) stud-

ies the possibility of conferring priestly ordination on elderly men, preferably indigenous, respected and accepted members of their communities," the document said.

Monsignor Fabio Fabene, under-secretary of the Vatican department that organizes synods, told Reuters that in responses to questionnaires to bishops in the region, there had been "very widespread" requests for "Viri Probati" to be considered.

Some Catholic scholars have said the approval of "viri probati" in the Amazon may eventually pave the way for their use elsewhere in the world as a response to the shortage of priests.

Pope Francis, in an interview with a German newspaper in 2017, said he was willing to consider ordaining "viri probati" men as priests in isolated communities. He has also mentioned their possible use on remote Pacific islands.

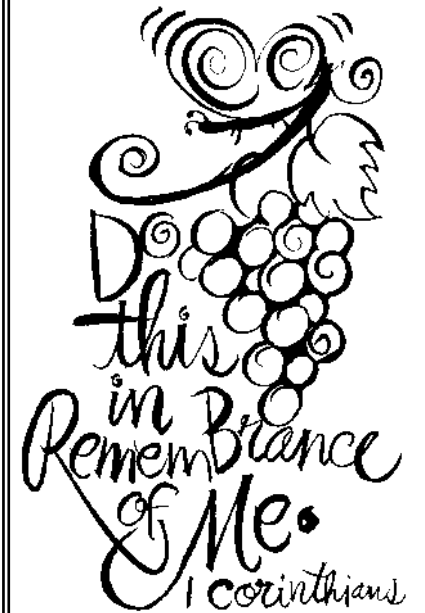
But he ruled out a general opening the priesthood to all married men or

(Shift continued) watering down the Catholic Church's commitment to celibacy, seen as a virtue that frees priests to devote their lives fully to serve God.

The synod on Oct 6-27 at the Vatican will include bishops and other representatives, including indigenous peoples, from Brazil, Bolivia, Peru, Ecuador, Colombia, Venezuela, Guyana, Suriname and French Guyana.

At the end of their conference, participants will vote on various articles in a final document, which will then go to the pope, who will decide whether to make it an official Apostolic Exhortation based on the synod meetings.

The document also issues a strong defense for the protection of the environment in the Amazon, deforestation, illegal mining and development projects that threaten native cultures and the delicate ecosystem vital for the planet.
