From Deacon John...

This story of Martha and Mary complements the story of the Good Samaritan. His story opens with the words "a certain man" and today's with "a certain woman." The Samaritan is an example of how a disciple should observe and act while Mary is an example of how to listen. Like the Samaritan, as a woman, Mary, is also marginalized. Yet, both do what is unexpected. Just as a Samaritan would not be a model for neighborliness, a woman was to prepare hospitality and certainly not sit with men. The stories show how we fulfill the dual command, love God and love neighbor.

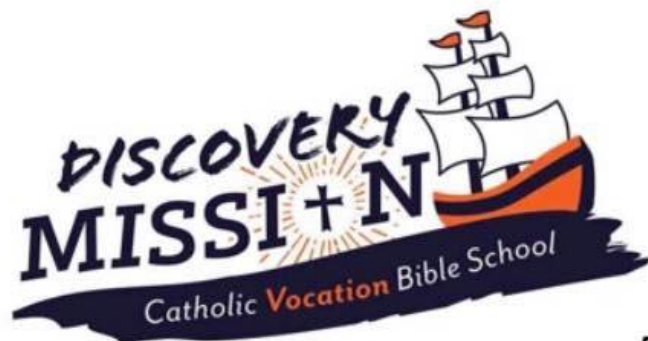

Pope Francis appoints new Bishop for Des Moines, USA

Bishop-elect Fr William Joensen will succeed Bishop Richard Pates, whose resignation from the pastoral governance of the Diocese of Des Moines was accepted by the Holy Father.

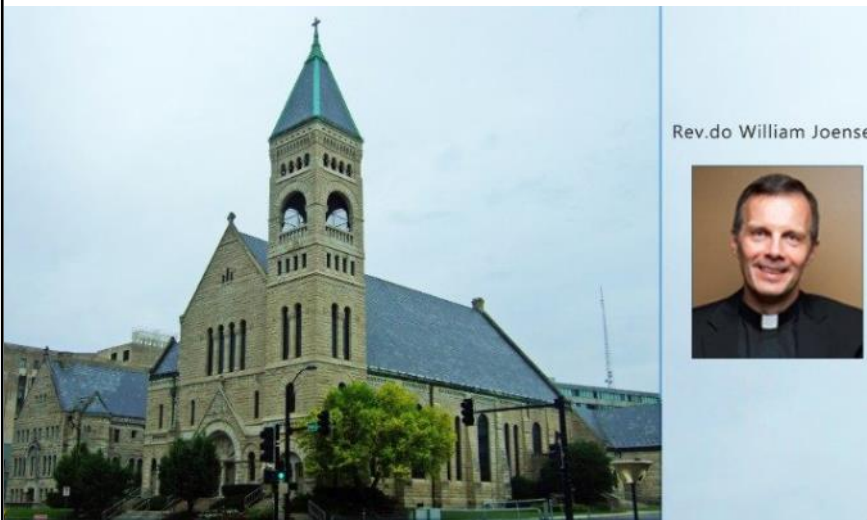

VATICAN CITY (CNS) Pope Francis has named Father William M Joensen as the new Bishop of Des Moines, USA. Father Joensen, a priest of the Archdiocese of Dubuque, has been serving as Associate Professor of Philosophy and Dean of Campus Spiritual Life at Loras College, a Catholic liberal arts college in Dubuque.

He was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Dubuque on 24 June 1989.

Following his ordination, Fr Joensen served as associate pastor at Sacred Heart Parish in Waterloo, and taught at Columbus High School (1989-1992).

In 1992 he became associate pas-

tor at Resurrection Parish in Dubuque, where he served until 1995. From 2003-2010, he was a chaplain at Clarke College in Dubuque.

Since 2001, Fr Joensen has been a spiritual director at the Saint Pius X Seminary in Dubuque, as well as Associate Professor of Philosophy and Dean of Campus Spiritual Life at Loras College.

Des Moines Catholic Bishop Richard Pates announces Retirement

(DES MOINES, IA) Bishop Richard Pates, the leader of Catholic Diocese of Des Moines, is retiring and returning to the Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis, according to a col-



umn he wrote in The Catholic Mirror.

Pates turned 75 on Feb. 12, the age bishops must submit their resignation to the pope as part of Canon Law. In his column, Pates said he sent Pope Francis his resignation. He served as the ninth bishop of Des Moines.

"As I prepare to take leave, my heart is full of joy and gratitude," Pates wrote in the column. "The past 10 years in the Des Moines diocese have flown by."

Pates wrote that it usually takes four months or longer to find a new bishop. He said he still plans to visit Des Moines, the ninth bishop of Des Moines, announced his resignation in February 2018 when he turned 75 years old. By Canon Law, bishops must resign at age 75. He has been bishop since 2008.

Known for his openness and welcoming personality, Pates' tenure has been marked by impressive growth, increased diversification of the local Catholic flock and ongoing fallout
