Alpha Youth at St. Anthony Daniel Parish

Fall is an exciting time around the parish. It's also an exciting time for me personally, as I begin my first year as a new pastor in a new community. My first months here have been a time of great blessing, due mostly to the warm welcome I've received. Our parish staff have also been invaluable in helping me settle in. We are blessed as a community.

This year, we're blessed in a special way to host the **Alpha Youth** programme. Based on the incredibly popular programme for adults, young people in **Grades 7-12** are invited to come and encounter the basic teachings of the Christian faith through a series of 12 short videos. The programme is open to all (Catholics, non-Catholic Christians, non-Christians), so students are encouraged to bring their friends and their questions. Alpha is a welcoming, pressure-free environment; a good place to come if we're wrangling with doubts or are simply unsure of how much space we have for faith in our lives.

Meetings will be held on the **first Tuesday of each month (Oct.-Jun.) from 7:00-9:00 PM in the Parish Life Centre and no registration is required.** Each evening will begin with a meal and include plenty of time for discussion and fellowship.

We're also greatly in need of adult and young adult volunteers to assist with small group discussion. Alpha provides us with a comprehensive manual to make the job easier, so all that's needed is energy and a desire to help young people encounter the Lord. An information/training session will be held for volunteers on **Tuesday, September 20th at 7:30 p.m. in the Marian Room.** Please contact Father Allen by phone or email if you're interested in assisting.
